THE WANDERING CHORISTERS Today we travelled to Conwy. The weather was sunny and warm when we left Frodsham, but as we motored into Wales it became overcast. We parked the car and walked down to the quay so that we could eat our picnic. From the car park we had to climb quite a lot of steps to reach the main road that would eventually bring us out to a pathway leading to the sea front. We found ourselves a picnic table and were immediately joined by pigeon, ravens and seagulls that stood and peered at us hoping we would drop some scraps of food for them. After our lunch we decided we would walk around the walls which is high up and overlooks the town with wonderful surrounding views. Sadly, part way round we found out that a great deal of the walk had been closed off, we think for repairs, so we ended up walking around the town through the side streets that we wouldn't normally have walked, and it was interesting to find quaint little shops we hadn't noticed before. In total we covered just over 3 miles and ended up in a little side street coffee shop that we have visited before. The owner, called Mario remembered us. We had also met an elderly gentleman last time we were there, and he had popped in for a coffee as well. We got chatting to him asking him how he was as we noticed his mobility was greatly impaired from the last time we had seen him. He said he found it difficult to walk now without the aid of his stick. We felt a bit sad for him as he lives alone having lost his wife just over a year ago. The cafe owners have taken him under their wing and allow him to sit in the cafe for as long as he wishes, which we thought was really lovely. We also got chatting to a couple
