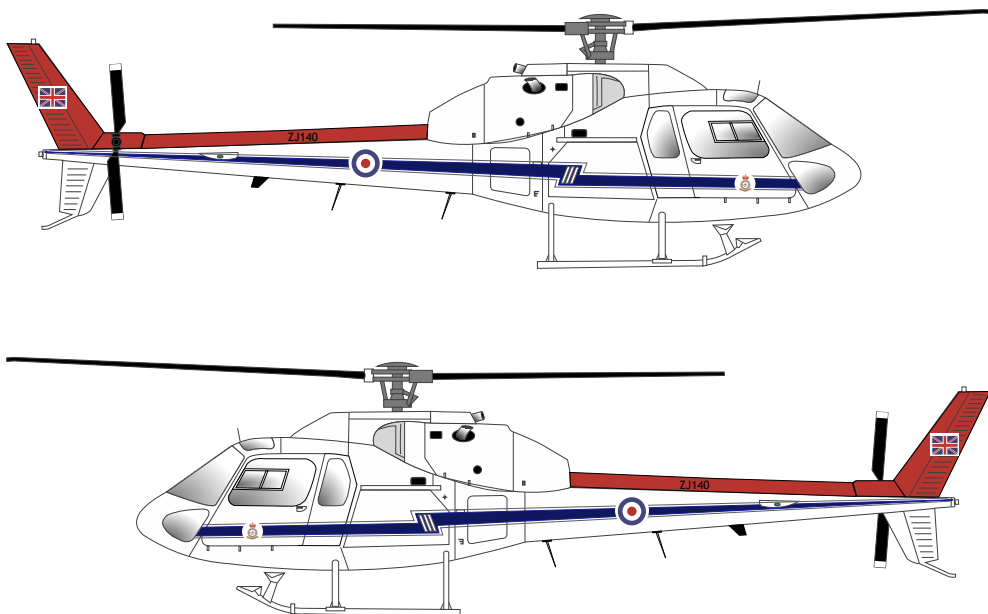

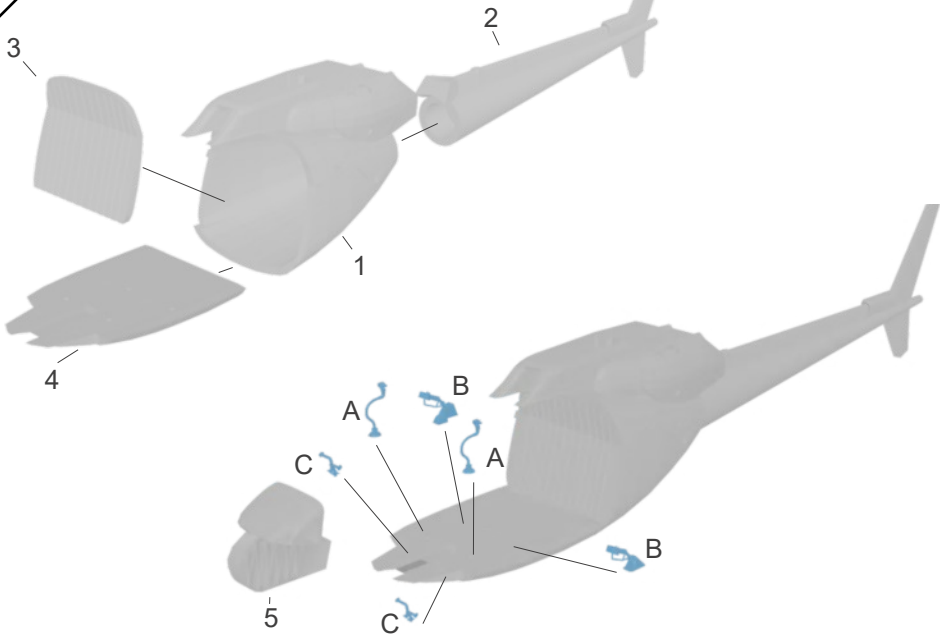
AS355 TWIN SQUIRREL

Study of the assembly plan and recognition of all resin, clear and metal parts
The use of cyanoacrylate type glue for all resin and metal parts
Cleaning all parts with soap and water before being assembled
Numbers in red show the decals to be applied

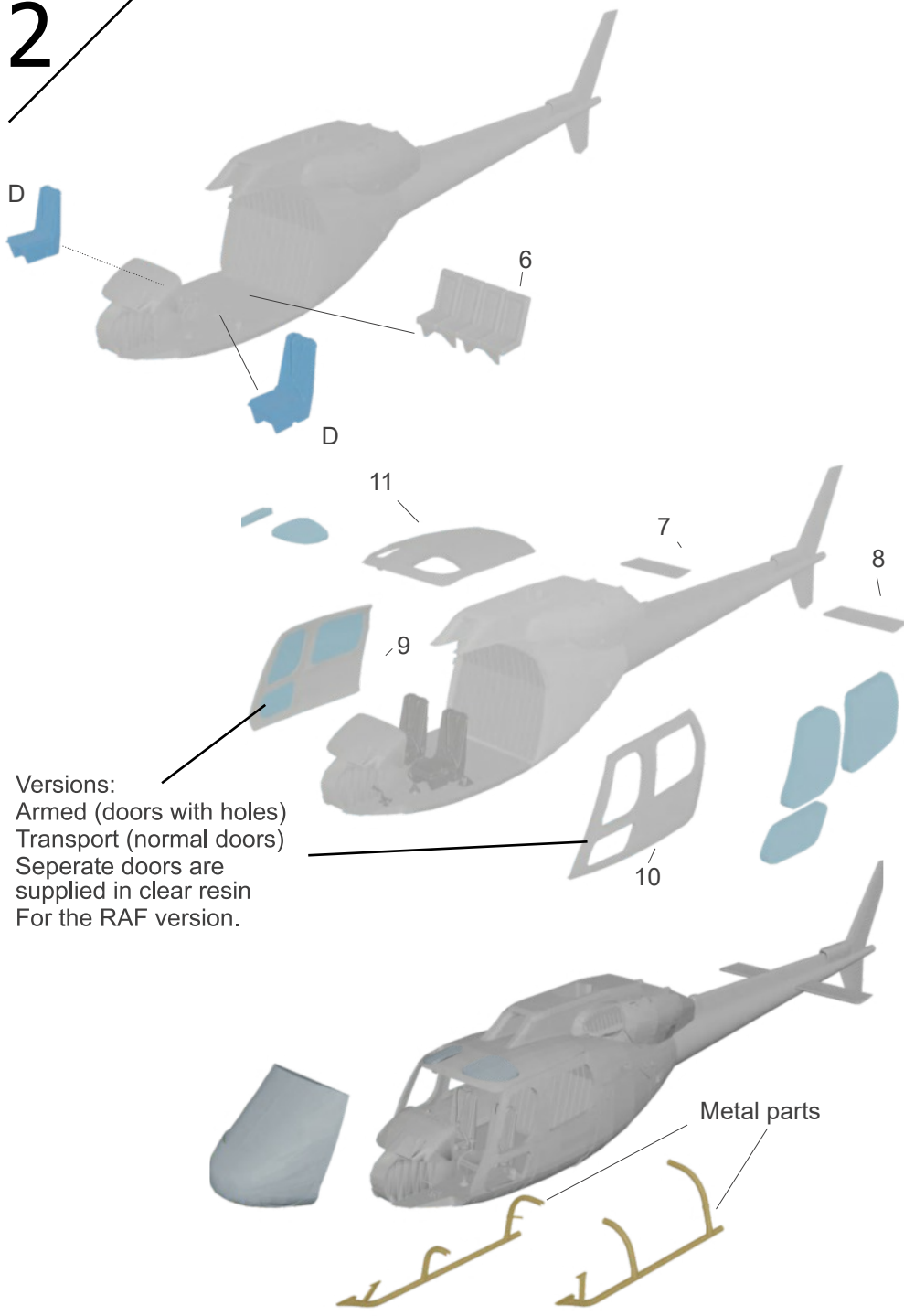
Attention Brazilian Decals

The decals are printed on a continuous sheet of film and are very thin.
They must be cut as close to the drawings to be placed in water and applied.
The extra numerals are used to compose different helicopter serial numbers.

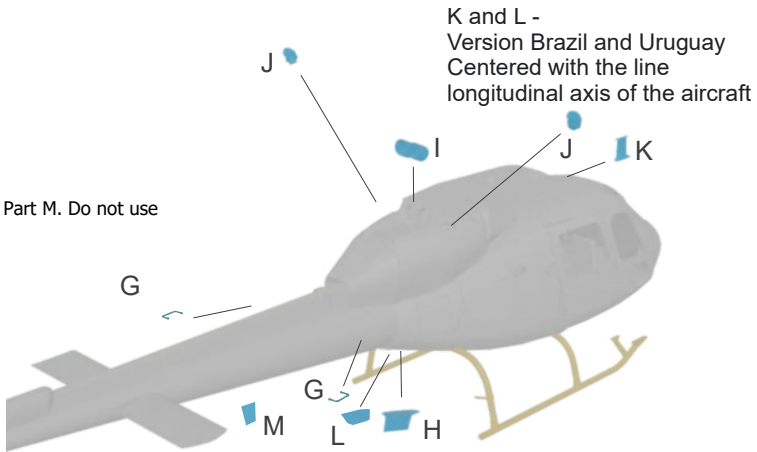

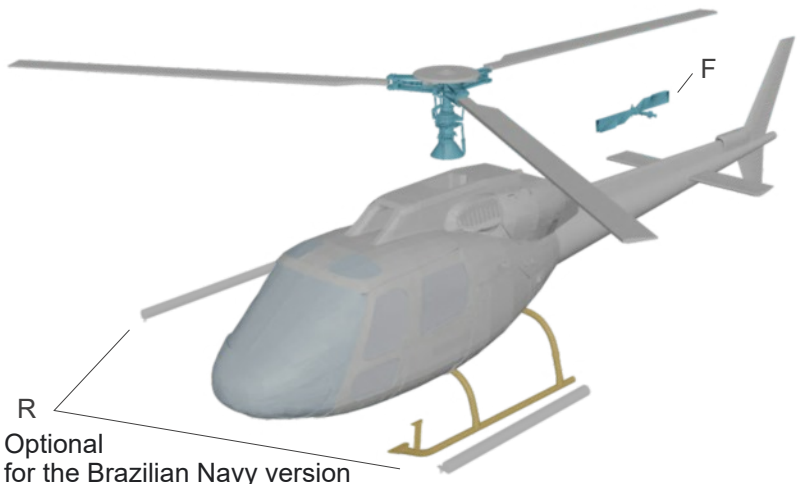
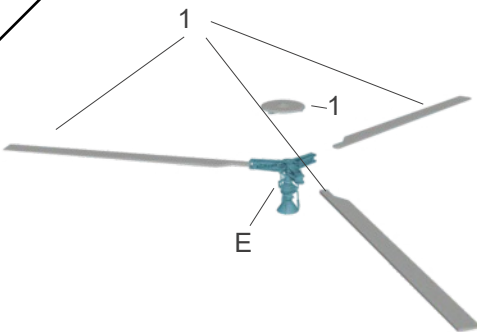
RAF aircraft only fit Part M. Do not use Parts H, K or L.



H and M (French Version) Centered with the line longitudinal axis of the aircraft

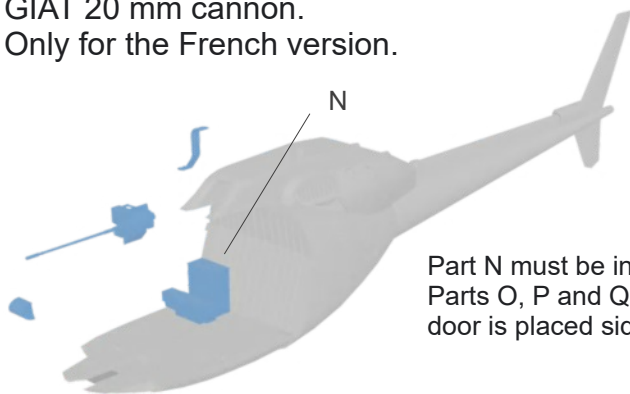

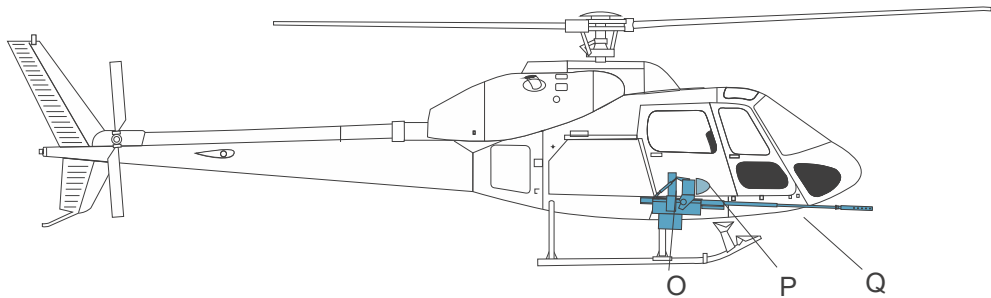

Parts O, P and Q must be assembled after the door is placed side.



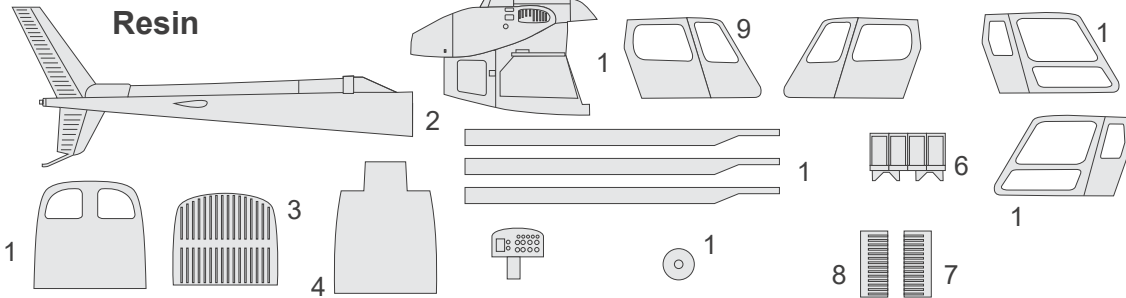

INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove any flash by gently snapping off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
- Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix parts.
- Gluing is easier if mating surfaces are slightly sanded to roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any dust before gluing.
- Before painting, thoroughly wash all parts in warm water with detergent.
- We recommend the application of a base coat in a light colour to show any blemishes prior to final painting.

WARNING & SAFETY!

- These parts are moulded in polyurethane resin. Please take care when sanding and cleaning up the resin by wearing a dust mask or other protective breathing device to avoid inhalation of the dust particles.
- Wash hands, resin parts and the work surface after sanding resin.
- When using Super-glue or two-part epoxy glue, please take precautions to avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- It is also advisable to wear a mask to avoid breathing in any fumes from the glue or work in a ventilated room.
- The use of barrier creams on hands or wearing disposable gloves, and working in a well ventilated area, is strongly recommended.
- Not suitable to children under 14 years of age.
