



## A Stage 1 - Base Unit






4 x A4 -Cut of centre of wheels

Drill out the back of the hub caps A5 so that A5 pushes into the hole Wityhout any force.






Phase 1 Completed in normal towing position

Ensure locating holes Are drill out before Fitting starts. Dry fit first and once Everything lines up, Fix with super glue




Launcher platform In launch/raised position






Phase 1 and Phase 2 completed.






It is important that You clean up the Main body of The rocket and ensure All 8 holes as drilled Around the main rear Ring.

Also there should be A hole on the rear Ring of the boaster Rockets for the Large fins.






C1 Rocket main body Note 8 No holes around This rear ring. 4 No for the booster Rockets and 4 No For the small finlets C3













## Instructions

- INSTRUCTIONS
  Remove any flash by gently snapping off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
  Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix parts.
  Cikling is sealer if mating surfaces are slightly sanded to roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any outs before gluing, or so that the state of the surface of
