






Clean up

Stage 1 is to clean up all the parts, cut from resin runners and wash in warm soapy water. Once all the parts have been washed & dried, but back in plastic bags for safe keeping.

Stage 2 - Wheels and chassis.



Fit chassis
Part 2 to the
main underside of the body
Part 1. Ensure you get this
lined up and axle spacing.
A tip I used was blue tack
the front and back wheels
onto the chassis to line all
up.



I fitted the front wheel on both sides and then the rear Inner wheel on one Side to ensure Everything sat flat and level.




Once I was happy With everything, I then fitted the outer rear wheels.






It is important you follow these steps as if Not is is difficult later on to fit the resin Inserts. Note Part 11 direction of parts. Also, Part 13 and 14 which way around they Fit.


Lastly, Part 15 sits flush with the rear body So the small resin lugs need sanding off.

Stage 4 - Cabin Detailing



Fit the gear levers etc, Parts 24, 25 & 26 before anything else. Fit steering wheel column Part 19, steering wheel Part 20 and hand brake Part 23.

Stage 5 - Front Detailing





Fit the front bumper Part 9 Followed by the radiator grill Part 10.


Fit headlights Part 29 and 30. Fit warning towing bracket 31. Note we do not include the Towing bracket.

Fit windscreen 20 and glazing. Note, paint windscreen before Fitting the glazing.















INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove any flash by gently snapping off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
 Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix
- Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix parts.
 Gluing is easier if mating surfaces are slightly sanded to roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any dust before gluing.
 Before paining, thoroughly wash all parts in warm water with defergent.
 We recommend the application of a base coat in a light colour to show any blemishes prior to final painting.

WARNING & SAFETY!

- These parts are moulded in polyurethane resin. Please take care when sanding and cleaning up the resin by wearing a dusk mask or other protective breathing device to avoid inhalation of the dust particles.
- Wash hands, resin parts and the work surface after
- Wash hands, resin parts and the work surface after sanding resin.
 When using Super-glue or two-part epoxy glue, please take precautions to avoid contact with skin and eyes.
 It is also advisable to wear a mask to avoid breathing in any furner form the glue or work in a ventilated from.
 The use of barrier creams on hands or wearing area, is strongly recommended.
 Not suitable to children under 14 years of age.
