
#### Clean up

Stage 1 is to clean up all the parts, cut from resin runners and wash in warm soapy water. Once all the parts have been washed & dried, but back in plastic bags for safe keeping.



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
## Stage 2 - Wheels and chassis.




Fit the rear axles to the rear wheels. Leave aside to dry. Fit to main body as shown.

Fit front axles to the front wheels and then fit to body.


Once you are happy, Ensure the model sits flat and level.




## Stage 3 - Internal Detailing





Ensure you do not cut off the small triangular bits under the seats. Fit seats to main body Part 1.



Fit gear stick Part 13 as shown. Fit handbrake and & wheel drive selector Part 12. The two levers will need to be bent as shown.








This is the 3D CAD Model showing the original break down of the parts

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## Stage 5 - Small details





Fit the two wing mirrors Parts 18 and 19.

Part 20 is optional as some tugs have this front and Back.


The complete internal cab Should be painted and finished at this stage. Internal colour of body is the same as external colour apart from when painted Desert Sand, the internal colour remained NATO Green

## Stage 6 - Finishing and Detailing























#### General Colours:

Floor - NATO Green with Black anti slip mats Wall - NATO Green/Yellow Seats - Dark Grey/Black Ceiling - Light green quilt Dash Board - Black Steering wheel - Black Gear Sticks - Dark Green with either Black or red knob Hand brake lever - Dark Green with Black knob 4 wheel selector - Dark Green with Red Knob

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove any flash by gently snapping off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
   Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix
- Only use Super-gue to a two-part epoxy gue to itx parts.
   Gluing is easier if mating surfaces are slightly sanded to roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any dust before gluing.
- dust before gluing.

  Before paining, thoroughly wash all parts in warm water with detergent.

  We recommend the application of a base coat in a light colour to show any blemishes prior to final painting.

#### WARNING & SAFETY!

- These parts are moulded in polyurethane resin. Please take care when sanding and cleaning up the resin by wearing a dusk mask or other protective breathing device to avoid inhalation of the dust
- Wash hands, resin parts and the work surface after
- sanding resin. When using Super-glue or two-part epoxy glue, please
- The use of barrier creams on the program to pure your case.
