







ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS AS350 ECUREUIL/SQUIRREL


Study of the assembly plan and recognition of all resin, clear and metal parts The use of cyanoacrylate type glue for all resin and metal parts Cleaning all parts with soap and water before being assembled Numbers in red show the decals to be applied


Attention Brazilian Decals

The decals are printed on a continuous sheet of film and are very thin. They must be cut as close to the drawings to be placed in water and applied. The extra numerals are used to compose different helicopter serial numbers.

















Brazilian Versions Common Decals






Brazilian Navy Version 1






Aerospatiale AS350B Squirrel, HC-723 Squadron, Royal Australian Navy, 'Operation Damask'.


