













#### Cabin Assembly





Kit floor with seat risers sanded off. Two thin plasticard strips which were Sanded right down to almost nothing. \*Note, 2 small plasticard strips with hes in on end.

Above: Rear seats, note cabin colour and seat colours. Also note rear cabin bulkhead behind seats



Above: Front cabin seats are black with light grey cushions. Note\* two bars behind seats which will need to be made From sprue, wire or plastic rod. These fit into the strip behind The front seats.

Cockpit tub fitted into fuselage half's. Note fuselage Modifications to take New intake ducts for The RAF aircraft. Also The rear air grills parts 10 and 11 have been Fitted. Note plasticard Backing to help locate These and secure.

Above right & below left: Completed fuselage and tail during clean up process.




Note, tail planes do not have the vertical Planes. Remove these








### Final Detailing

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove any flash by gently snapping off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
   Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix
- Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix parts.
   Gluing is easier if mating surfaces are slightly sanded to roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any dust before gluing.
   Before paining, thoroughly wash all parts in warm water with delergent.
   We recommend the application of a base coat in a light colour to show any blemishes prior to final painting.

- WARNING & SAFETY! These parts are moulded in polyurethane resin.
  Please take care when sanding and cleaning up the reash by wearing a dusk mask or other protective breathing device to avoid inhalation of the dust particles.

- Wash hands, resin parts and the work surface after sanding resin.
   When using Super-glue or two-part epoxy glue, please take precaudions to avoid contact with sikin and eyes.
   It is also advisable to wear a mask to avoid breathing in any furnes from the glue or work in a verillated room.
   The use of barrier creams on hands or wearing area, is strongly recommended.
   Anot suitable to children under 14 years of age.
