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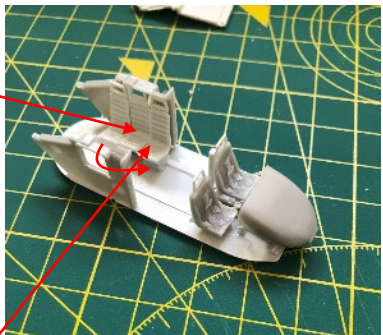
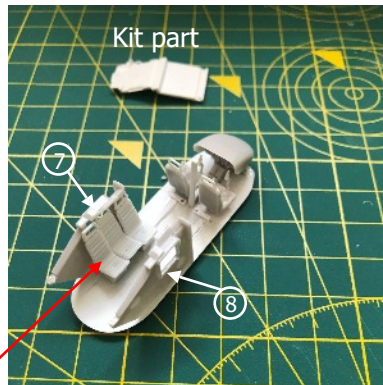
Cabin Assembly



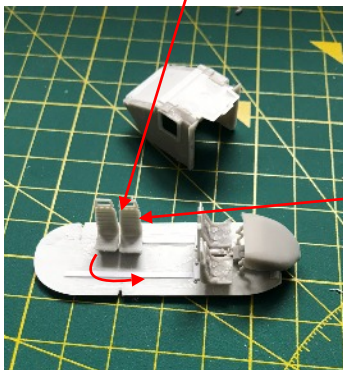
Kit floor with seat risers sanded off.

Above: Rear seats, note cabin colour and seat colours. Also note rear cabin bulkhead behind seats



Above: Front cabin seats are black with light grey cushions. Note* two bars behind seats which will need to be made From sprue, wire or plastic rod. These fit into the strip behind The front seats.

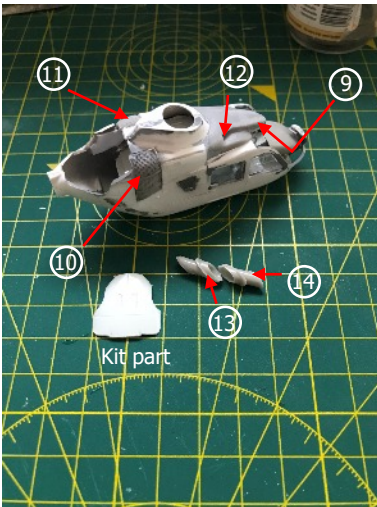

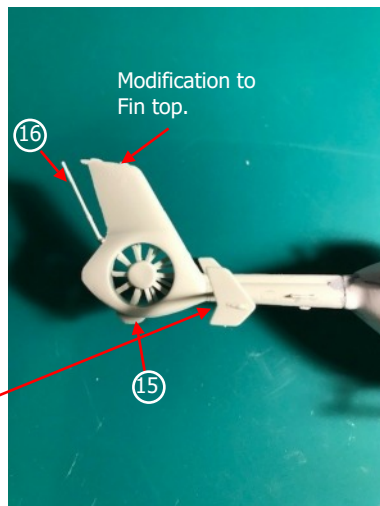

INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove any flash by gently sanding off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
- Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix parts.
- Gluing is easier if mating surfaces are slightly sanded to roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any dust before gluing.
- Before painting, thoroughly wash all parts in warm water with detergent.
- We recommend the application of a base coat in a light colour to show any blemishes prior to final painting.

WARNING & SAFETY!

- These parts are moulded in polyurethane resin. Please take care when sanding and cleaning up the resin by wearing a dust mask or other protective breathing device to avoid inhalation of the dust particles.
- Wash hands, resin parts and the work surface after sanding resin.
- When using Super-glue or two-part epoxy glue, please take precautions to avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- It is also advisable to wear a mask to avoid breathing in any fumes from the glue or work in a ventilated room.
- The use of barrier creams on hands or wearing disposable gloves, and working in a well ventilated area, is strongly recommended.
- Not suitable for children under 14 years of age.
