










Cabin Assembly

Part 6 is civil. Decal sheet can be used for the civil instrument panel if required. (Supplied in kit)






Note Parts 7 and 8 are the windows screens that go behind the main cabin windows.


Note, look at pictures as the blinds are not fitted to the Fire Exit windows. These are finished Light Grey.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove any flash by gently snapping off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
 Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix
- Only use Super-glue or a wor-par epucy your bunk parts.
 Gluing is easier if maling surfaces are slightly sanded roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any dust before gluing. Hefore gluing, before paining, thoroughly wash all parts in warm water with detergent.
