

Stage 1: Clean up, separate and wash the resin parts in warm soapy water and leave to dry.





Stage 2: Fit rear wheels Parts 2 and 3 to main body Part 1.

Stage 3: Fit front wheels, Parts 4 and 5 to main body. Ensure the tractor sits level.







Stage 4: Fit rear tow bracket Part 6 to the rear of the main body, Part 1. This sits central and against the lower edge of the rear body.

Stage 5: Fit steering column, Part 7 and steering wheel Part 8.

Option: Some tractors has a steel mesh screen across the rear so that wheel chocks, tools and chains etc could be safely carried. (This item is not supplied)

Optional wire cage across rear to store wheel chocks and chains etc.

The main colour is BS381C 356 Golden Yellow.

Some tractors have a Black painted Rear panel across the body.

Seat cushion was very Dark Grey.

Tow hooks and clips were Red or Black.

Marking include number plate in Black to front and back. The back Plate is vertical. Both have white Lettering. (Available on Air-Graphics Decal sheet AIR72-015)

I have seen pictures with Squadron Zaps on the sides and also a large Black RN on either side. (HMS Hermes 1960's)
