









Stage 1 - Clean up and Preparation


Clean up all the resin parts, cut from resin runners and wash in warm soapy water. Once all the parts have been washed & dried, but back in plastic bags for safe keeping.



There is also glazing template & strip plus orange warning beacon. In addition we have also included two plasticard Channels for the cab riser Bars.

Main body & wheels








Fit stub axles to wheels & set aside to dry.

Ensure axle locating holes In the main body Part 1 are drilled out to take the stub axles. Fit diagonal wheels and ensure the main body is flat and does not rock.












Main body fittings



Plasticcard channels 20mm long





2 No plasticard channels Either side, 1.5mm from Corner. Sits 1mm below top. 2 small plasticard strips (Optional) for cable guides.












29 43 39 Oposite side





Please note there are 4 No Parts 45 & 46. Note 1 spare mirror. Parts 41 and 43 not used on my Model. However, they are for the rear mirrors if needed.

Not shown is Part 48 (Orange beacon light), clear glazing and 2 No plasticard strip channels.





Instructions

- Remove any flash by gently snapping off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
 Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix parts.

 Gluing is easier if mating surfaces are slightly sanded
- Gluing is easier if mating surfaces are slightly sanded to roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any dust before gluing.
 Before paining, throoughly wash all parts in warm water with detergent.
 We recommend the application of a base coat in a light colour to show any blemishes prior to final paintir

 These parts are moulded in polyurethane resin.

 Please take care when sanding and cleaning up the resin by wearing a dusk mask or other protective breathing device to avoid inhalation of the dust particles.
- Wash hands, resin parts and the work surface after

 When using Super-glue or two-part epoxy glue, pleas take precautions to avoid contact with skin and eyes.
 It is also advisable to wear a mask to avoid breathing
- in any furnes from the glue or work in a ventilated room
 The use of barrier creams on hands or wearing
 disposable gloves, and working in a well ventilated
 area, is strongly recommended.
- Not suitable to children under 14 years of age.
