Chassis Assembly



Stage 1: Cut of resin flash
From the chassis so it looks like
The pictures.
Fit chassis Part no 1 to cab base
Part 20 as this locates exhaust
Part no 7.

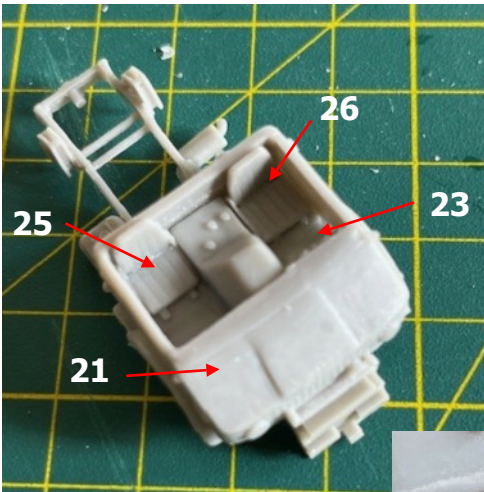
Stage 2: Fit rear axle Part no 3
& drive shaft Part no 5 (longer rod)
Fit fuel tank Part no 13.
Not which around around the axle
Fits and also the fuel tank has
The filler cap at the top and to
The front.



Stage 3: Fit front axle Part no 2
& drive shaft 4 (smaller rod).
Fit wheels Parts 15 -18 and also
spare wheel Part no 19.

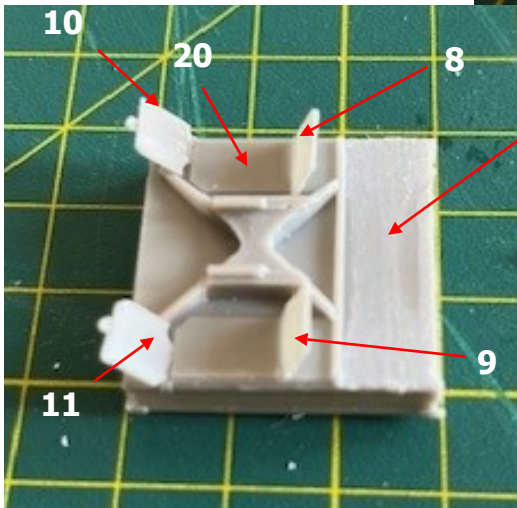
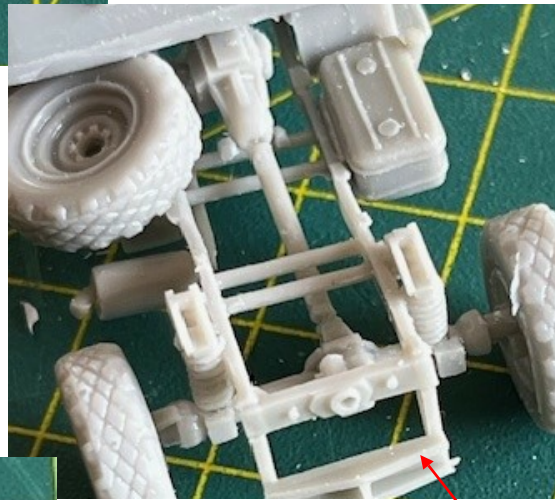
Cab and back Assembly



Stage 4: Fit cab Part 21 and fit the steering wheel Part no 23 (not shown) as indicated. Fit seats Parts 25 and 26.

Stage 5: fit rear bracket Part no 14 to chassis.

Stage 6: Rear body part 20 has the mud flaps fitted before fixing to the chassis. Not Parts 10 and 11 are the rear pair.



Note: Part 20 needs the moulding tab **14** sanded off as shown.

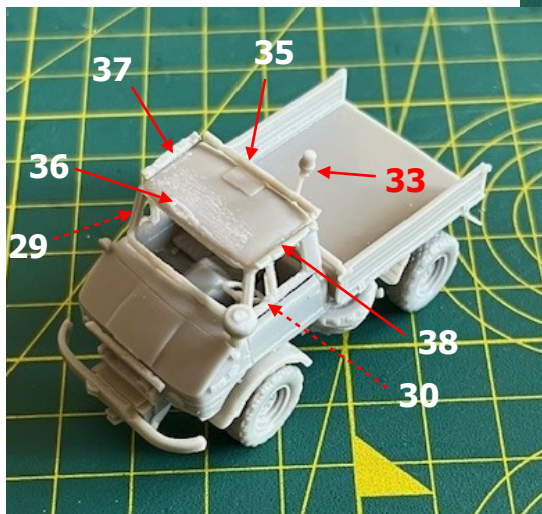
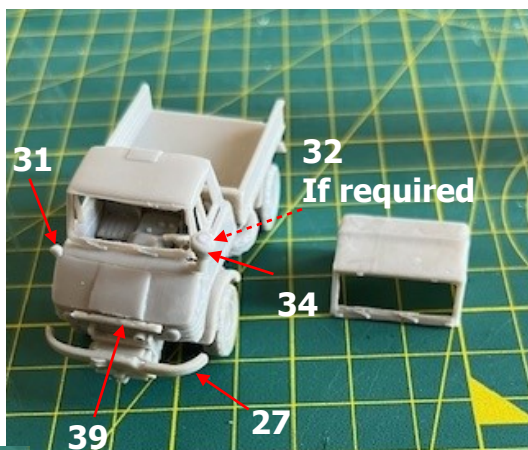
Final Assembly



Ready to finish:

Stage 7: Fit front bumper
Part no 27 and the Hessian
Roll if required (Harrier Field
Force) Part no 39.

Fit air filter Part no 34 and side.
Note not all Unimogs have this fitted)
Spot light Part no 31 on the left
hand side.
If required and check reference
fit the spot light Part no 32 on right
hand side.



Stage 8: Choose which hood you are
Going to use. Note the soft top does
Not have the Hessian window blinds.

If the hard top is used as shown;
Fit Parts 37 and 38 to the sides, Part
36 to the front and Part 35 to the rear.

Fit the beacon pole and light, Part no 33.
This can be replaced by clear orange
Light if required.

Lastly, and not shown, fit wing mirrors
Parts no 29 and 30 if required.

Gulf War Modifications

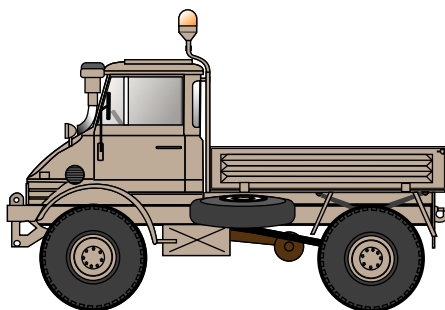
The British Army used the Unimogs in the Gulf War, named Op Granby during 1990/91 by the SAS as there resupply Vehicle.

But did have a roll bar behind the seats.

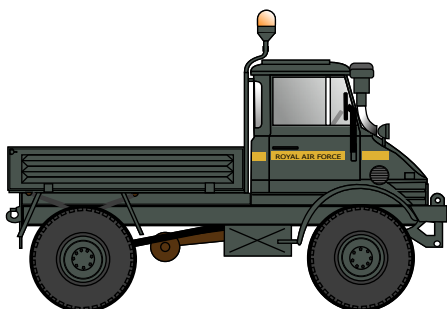




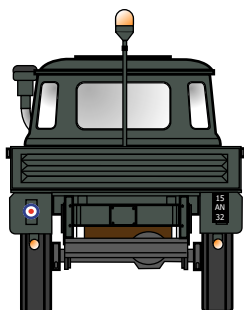
RAF Mercedes Unimog 406
Standard NATO Green



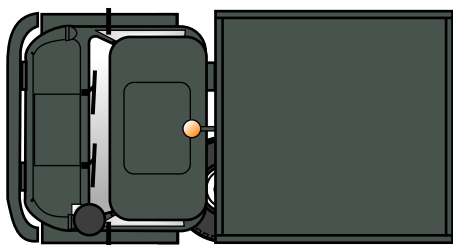
RAF Mercedes Unimog 406
Op Granby 1991 - Gulf War Pink



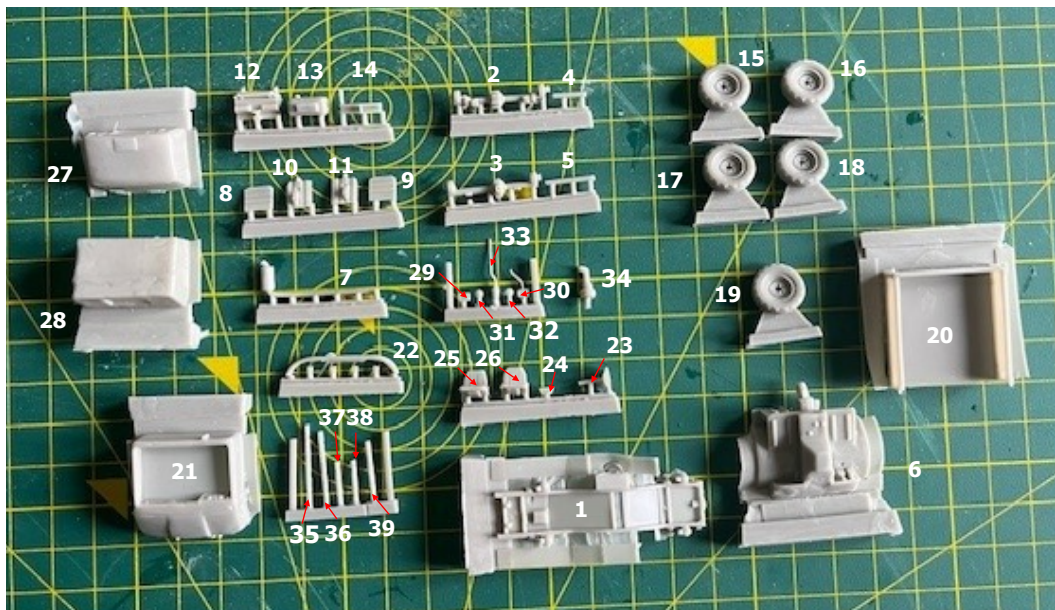
RAF Mercedes Unimog 406

Parts



INSTRUCTIONS

- Remove any flash by gently snapping off, or cutting with a scalpel and then lightly sanding.
- Only use Super-glue or a two-part epoxy glue to fix parts.
- Gluing is easier if mating surfaces are slightly sanded to roughen the resin before gluing. Also clean off any dust before gluing.
- Before painting, thoroughly wash all parts in warm water with detergent.
- We recommend the application of a base coat in a light colour to show any blemishes prior to final painting.

WARNING & SAFETY!

- These parts are moulded in polyurethane resin. Please take care when sanding and cleaning up the resin by wearing a dust mask or other protective breathing device to avoid inhalation of the dust particles.
- Wash hands, resin parts and the work surface after sanding resin.
- When using Super-glue or two-part epoxy glue, please take precautions to avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- It is also advisable to wear a mask to avoid breathing in any fumes from the glue or work in a ventilated room.
- The use of barrier creams on hands or wearing disposable gloves, and working in a well ventilated area, is strongly recommended.
- Not suitable to children under 14 years of age.
