



# BEREAVEMENT POLICY

## POLICY:

It is the policy of **TRUE HOLINESS DELIVERANCE TABERNACLE** to care for our member's when a death occurs in the immediate family. Immediate family members are defined as a member's spouse, parents, stepparents, sisters, brothers, children, stepchildren, grandparents, father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, or grandchild.

Special circumstances not outlined in this document must be handled on a case-by-case basis with the Pastor and Church Administrator and/or Bereavement leader. It is True Holiness Deliverance Tabernacle's intention to support members during times of grief and bereavement.

## PROCEDURE:

1. When a death occurs in a member's immediate family, the following assistance will be offered and available:
  - a. The Pastor will be contacted.
  - b. The member will be contacted to inquire of their immediate needs.
  - c. A resolution will be provided to the family.
  - d. A card will be mailed to the family from the church.
  - e. A flower will be sent to the funeral home from the church family.
  - f. The church will provide a dinner for the family. The family will be contacted to schedule a date and time for their meal to be delivered.
  - g. The church will assist with food items for the repast.
