HISTORY OF THE CHURCH

THDT was originally named Sanford Tabernacle of Prayer for all People, Inc. The church was founded in November 1978 by Overseer Carrie Buie Bryant and sixteen young people who took a stand to declare Holiness as God's standard of living for His people. The Jacksonville branch was established in 1980

after so many members were traveling back and forth. In March 1981, Pastor Bryant and forty-two members marched into our current facility debt free. This church was built with tithes, offerings and pledges. In addition to the ministries, the church had a daycare center, a business complex with a laundry mat, a Bible Book Store, a Designer's

Creation Boutique, and a Beauty and Barber Salon. It was a goal of the Pastor to see that the members were educated in the Word of God; therefore, a Tabernacle Bible Institute was established with certified personnel. In 2000, the name of the church was changed to True Holiness Deliverance Tabernacle by the Board of Trustees.
