## "The Invisible Bench" Skit

### Cast:

- 4+ Scouts
- (Optional) Narrator to introduce the skit

### Setup:

- Scouts are arranged in a line, "sitting" on an imaginary bench. Each Scout mimics sitting, with knees bent as though they're perched on a bench.

### Script:

**Scout 1:** Ah, I just love this invisible bench! So comfy and spacious. (Gestures as though patting the bench.)

**Scout 2:** Totally agree! Who needs real benches when this one's perfect? (Adjusts position slightly, still "sitting.")

**Scout 3:** I've been coming to sit on this invisible bench for years—it's always been here!

**Scout 4 (walking by):** Hey! What are you all doing?

**Scout 1:** What's it look like? We're sitting on the invisible bench!

**Scout 4:** The invisible bench? Oh, I moved that over *there* this morning! (Points to a different spot dramatically.)

**All Scouts on the bench (react in sync):** WHAAAAAAT?! (Pretend to fall down, crashing into each other.)

**Audience Reaction:** The group's synchronized "fall" and over-the-top expressions usually get a big laugh!

## "Drip Drip Drop" Skit

### Cast:

- 5+ Scouts (1 Narrator and 4+ participants)
- Due to BSA rules scouts are not allowed to put water on other scouts.

### Setup:

- The Narrator explains the "scientific experiment" happening, while participants sit in chairs in a straight line, close together, facing the audience.

### Script:

**Narrator (dramatically):** Ladies and gentlemen, today we present the story of what happens when four people sit under a leaky roof during a rainstorm. Watch closely!

**Scout 1 (pretending to feel a drip):** Uh-oh, I just got a drip on my head! (Uses their hand to "wipe" an imaginary drop and passes the gesture to Scout 2.)

**Scout 2 (reacts to the gesture):** Yikes! Me too! (Repeats the "wipe" gesture and passes it on to Scout 3.)

**Scout 3 (dramatically):** It's raining even harder now! (Mimics being drenched and passes the action to Scout 4.)

**Scout 4 (looks annoyed):** I'm soaked! Someone better fix that roof! (Pretends to shiver or wring out clothes.)

**Narrator (grinning):** Let me show you how we REALLY fix it! (Pretends to grab a water bucket and pretends to gently "drip" water from the small cup on the Scouts' heads, one by one.)

**All Scouts (overacting):** AHHH! STOP THE DRIP! WE'RE FLOODING!

**Ending Tip:** The Narrator can add a humorous twist, like pretending to "miss" and pour water on themselves or the audience (just a tiny splash!). Keep it light, funny, and interactive!

## "The Lost Wallet" Skit

### Cast:

- 5+ Scouts (1 Wallet Owner, 1 Honest Scout, and at least 3 "Finders")
- (Optional) Narrator to set the scene

### Setup:

- The Wallet Owner "loses" their wallet in a public place. The Honest Scout observes, while the Finders take turns reacting to the situation.

### Script:

**Narrator (optional):** Ladies and gentlemen, tonight we present a tale of honesty, good deeds, and the peculiar ways people react when they find a wallet.

**Wallet Owner (walking in, patting pockets):** Oh no! I've lost my wallet! What will I do?  
(Pretends to panic and walks away.)

**Finder 1 (picks up the wallet):** Wow! A wallet! I'm rich now! (Pretends to count imaginary cash, pockets the wallet, and sneaks offstage.)

**Finder 2 (picks up another imaginary wallet):** Aha! A wallet! (Looks around sneakily.) I'll keep it, but only after I treat myself to a big pizza first! (Runs offstage.)

**Finder 3 (picks up the wallet, looks around nervously):** Hmm, a wallet... Maybe I'll hold on to it, just in case the owner doesn't come back. (Shrugs and wanders off.)

**Honest Scout (walks over, finds the wallet):** Oh, someone lost their wallet! I'll make sure to turn it in so it can get back to its owner. (Steps forward and announces loudly.) Excuse me! Did anyone lose a wallet?

**Wallet Owner (runs back excitedly):** That's mine! Thank you so much!

**Honest Scout (hands over the wallet):** Here you go! Always happy to help.

**Narrator (steps forward, if used):** And there you have it, folks—a little reminder to always do the right thing and live by the Scout Law. Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful—you know the rest!

## "The Magical Changing Stick" Skit

### Cast:

- 3+ Scouts (1 Wizard, 2+ Participants)
- A stick or branch as the "Magical Stick" (simple prop)

**Setup:** The Wizard enters dramatically, holding the stick, and claims it has magical powers. Other Scouts interact with the stick, showcasing its "magic" in comical ways.

### Script:

**Wizard (enters dramatically):** Behold! I have discovered the most powerful object in the world—the Magical Changing Stick! It can transform anyone into whatever they desire! Who dares to try it first?

**Participant 1 (steps forward skeptically):** Magical? Ha! I don't believe it. Prove it can do something amazing!

**Wizard (waves the stick):** Abracadabra! Zippity-zip! You shall now become... a chicken!

**Participant 1 (starts clucking, flapping arms like a chicken, and acting silly):** Bawk bawk! Bawk bawk! It's amazing—I'm a chicken! (Keeps clucking as they exit the stage.)

**Wizard (waves the stick again):** Hocus pocus, kazam kaboom! You're now... a superhero!

**Participant 2 (strikes heroic poses, pretends to fly, and makes dramatic sound effects):** Pow! Bam! I'm saving the day! (Acts out a quick heroic scene before exiting.)

**Participant 3 (steps forward nervously):** Uh... can you make me really smart?

**Wizard (waves the stick with exaggerated flair):** Intellectibus Maximus! You're now the smartest person in the world!

**Participant 3 (adjusts "glasses" and speaks in an exaggerated intellectual tone):** Ah, yes. According to my calculations, this stick is actually a branch from the species *Magnifica Ridiculosa*! (Over-explains something silly and exits.)


### Final Twist:

**Wizard (looks at the stick and smirks):** And now... I'll use the magical stick on myself! (Waves it dramatically.) I shall become the most powerful wizard of all time!

**(Nothing happens. Wizard looks confused, taps the stick, and waves it again. Still nothing.)**

## "The Echo Canyon" Skit

### Cast:

- 3 or more Scouts
- (Optional) Narrator to set the scene

### Setup:

- The stage is set as "Echo Canyon," where voices bounce back in mysterious and funny ways.

### Script:

## "The Scout Barber Shop" Skit

### Cast:

- 4+ Scouts (1 Barber, 1 Customer, and 2-3 Assistants)

### Props:

- A chair for the "barber shop"
- Towel or cape (to pretend as a barber's cape)
- Over-the-top tools: big comb, fake scissors, spray bottle (not allowed to use actual water), etc.

### Setup:

- A Scout enters the "barber shop," looking for a haircut. The Barber and Assistants deliver a hilariously unusual experience.

### Script:

**Barber (standing near a chair):** Welcome to the Scout Barber Shop, where a good haircut is always an adventure! Take a seat!

**Customer (sits nervously):** Um, okay, but make it quick. I just need a simple trim.

**Barber (grinning):** Simple trim? Sure thing! (Turns to the Assistants.) Team, grab the tools!

**Assistants (enter with ridiculous props):** Comb ready! (Brandishes an oversized comb.) Scissors ready! (Holds pretend scissors.) Water spray ready! (Pretends to test a spray bottle, accidentally "spraying" the Barber.)

**Barber (pretending to be soaked):** Careful! Okay, let's begin.

**Barber and Assistants (proceed with dramatic antics):**

- Comb wildly, as if styling a masterpiece.
- Pretend to snip with exaggerated hand movements.
- Use "spray bottle" liberally, pretending to drench the Customer.
- Make silly comments, e.g., "Ah, perfect! A modern masterpiece!" or "You'll be the talk of the troop!"

**Customer (reacts with increasing confusion):** Are you sure you know what you're doing?! This feels... strange!

**Barber (revealing a pretend mirror):** All done! Ta-da! You look fabulous!

**Customer (screams or faints dramatically):** What have you done?!

## "The Talking Dog" Skit

## "The Invisible Rope" Skit

### Cast:

- 2 Scouts (pulling an "invisible rope")
- 1 or more Scouts or leaders (playing the unsuspecting passersby)

### Script:

**Scout 2 (pretends to cry):** That was our favorite invisible rope!

**All Scouts (dramatically and together):** WHY?!

### Cast:

### Script:

**Doctor:** There you go! Remember, Scoutitis isn't so bad—as long as you have plenty of Scout Spirit!

**All Scouts (together, waving):** And a good Scout is always prepared!

## "The Ladder of Success" Skit

### Cast:

- 4+ Scouts (1 Narrator, 1 Climber, and 2-3 Assistants)
- A prop ladder or an imaginary one works fine!

### Script:

### Cast:

- Scout 1: Customer
- Scout 2: Knot Specialist (wearing a silly hat or glasses for comedic effect)
- Scout 3+: Assistants or Demonstrators

## "The Stuck Tent Zipper" Skit

### Cast:

- Scout 1: Camper with the stuck zipper
- Scout 2: Helpful Scout
- Scout 3+: Various "helpers" (each with a unique idea for solving the problem)

**Setup:** Scout 1 is sitting near a tent, struggling with a stuck zipper. Other Scouts take turns offering increasingly silly and exaggerated solutions to fix the zipper.

### Script:
