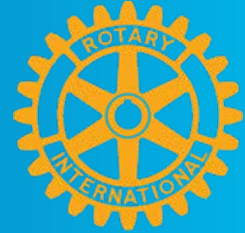

YOUTH PARK UPDATE & MORE

Without the benefit of a report from Brian, we've done our best to highlight some of the progress continuing to be made at the Youth Park.

- * Continued GREAT progress on the Concession Building via contractor G&S Glass.
- * Junior Field upgrades and repairs after a tough winter on a tender new seeding - topsoil, sprinklers and other irrigation improvements.
- * The Rotary Corner Project, partially funded through a District Service Grant, continues to make progress with the ground shaped to accept aggregate for parking, topsoil for planting trees and shrubs, and decorative rock to protect the landscaping.
- * The Skate Park received an 8" water line for a new City Water Main Extension from 4th St.
- * Ordered 6 new low riser bleachers for the Junior Field, T-Ball Field, and the Major/Minor Boys Field.

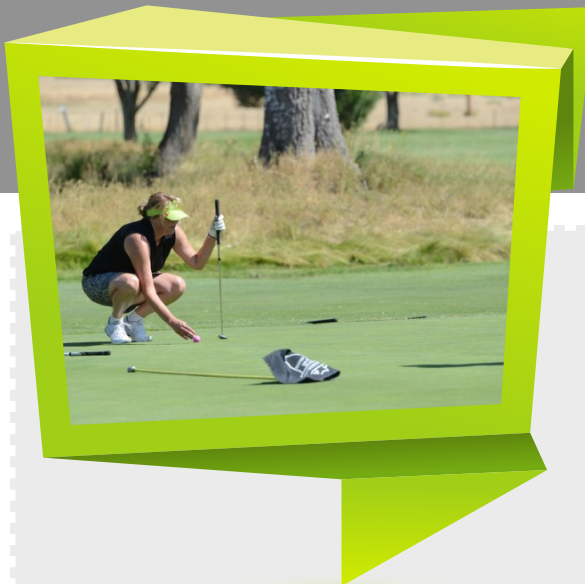

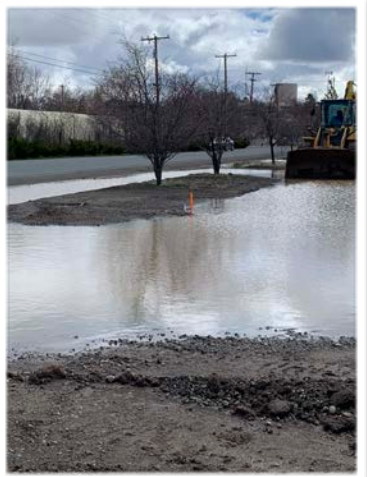


Major irrigation system installed !
