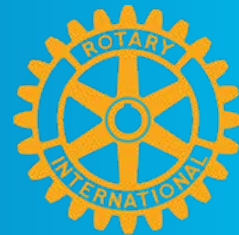

- \* **The Phase 3 Budget is being revised and will be provided to the Club and ARCF.**



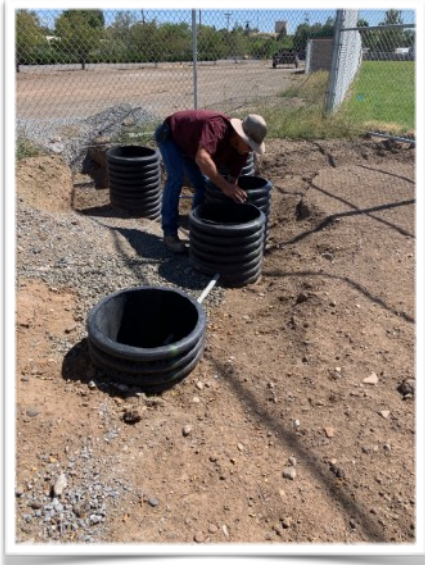

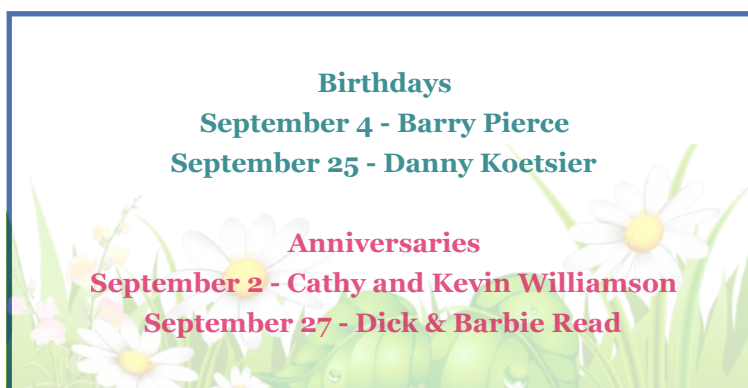
