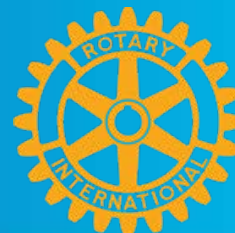

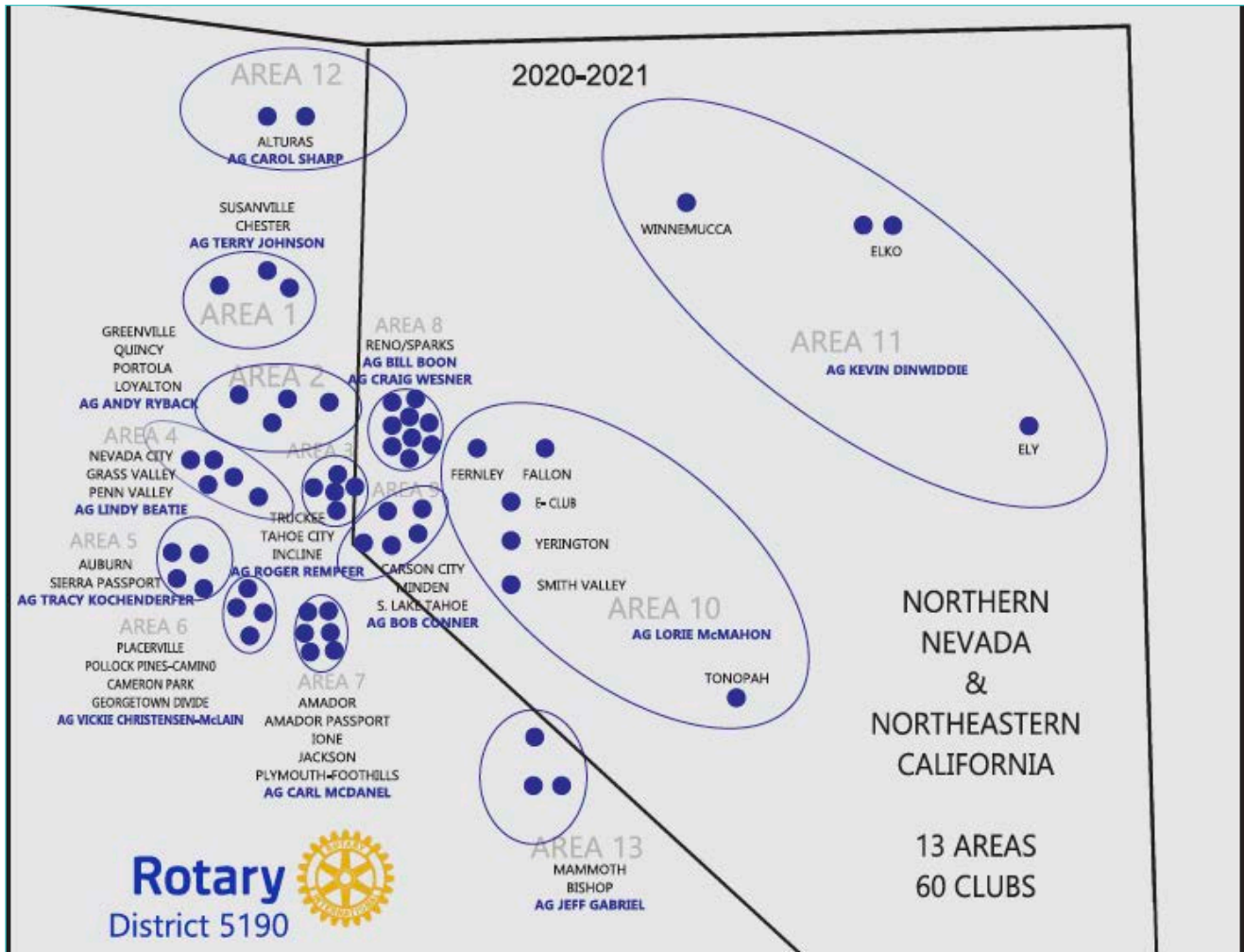

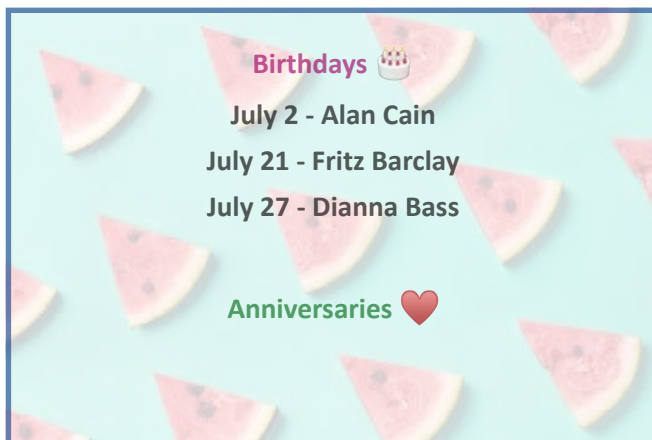

For a parade that took every twist and turn during the planning stages... it was simply a fantastic outcome to have so many participants and observers just enjoying time outside and seeing each other!

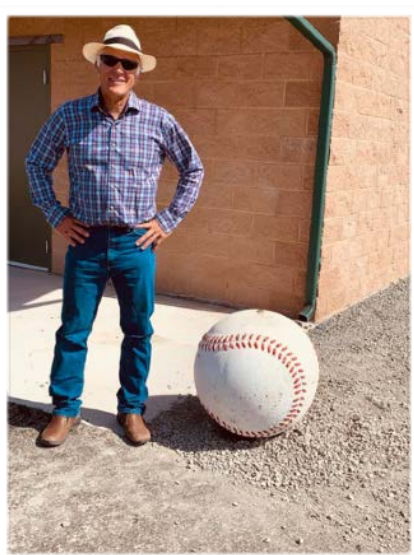
Past District Governor Alan Cain rode for the Backcountry Horsemen's group.
