


PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


## Meet Rotary District 5190 Governor Jeff Gabriel

- A talented Interact member hand-made an Easter card signed by all the kiddos for the Warner View Skilled Nursing Center residents.
- Students showed pride in their school by picking up trash on the campus.
- This year's "Purple Pinkie" project raised enough money to vaccinate 1,900 children worldwide from the harmful effects of polio.
- Since the Interact Club was charted in 2015, the Interactors have raised over \$2,200, which has helped protect 11,600 children.
