# 100 Blacks in Law-enforcement

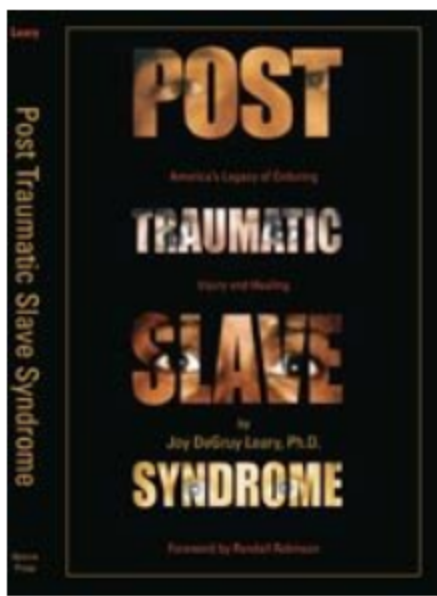
