Hoosier Burn Camp helps provide life changing experiences for young people who have suffered the pain and trauma associated with burn injury.

In the first 15 years, the programs have positively impacted over 250 young people and touched thousands of lives.

With worry-free environments where young burn survivors can be "just one of the kids" while they develop the personal strength to reach their highest potential. Our events for burn survivors, their families and supporters are hosted throughout the year.

First conceived by the Indiana State Fire Marshal's Office and Riley Hospital employees, Hoosier Burn Camp was founded in 1997 to extend opportunities for social and emotional healing to severe burn survivors in Indiana ages 8 to 18.

The annual tradition at Camp Tecumseh summer camp, is a life-enriching experience for young burn survivors. Through the generosity of donors, camp is provided at no cost to the kids and their families.

Camp is open to young people ages 8 to 18 who have experienced serious burn injury or have been treated for burn injury requiring hospitalization in the state of Indiana.

Campers participate in traditional and more unique camp activities, like glass blowing, basket weaving, guitar lessons and outdoor sports, which are designed to build confidence, develop courage and build on each camper's personal strengths.

Our team of dedicated volunteers have joined together to develop positive relationships with young people and inspire them to reach their highest potential.


