#### PRE-POUR JOBSITE READINESS CHECKLIST

- Jobsite is accessible for truck and crew (clear of debris, obstacles, mud)
- Weather forecast reviewed; pour window confirmed
- Pour path and exit route planned
- Forms are in place, square, level, and properly braced
- Blockouts, sleeves, and embeds are installed per plans
- Dimensions double-checked
- Subgrade is compacted and approved
- Vapor barrier installed (if required)
- Rebar or mesh in place and properly tied/lifted
- Beams clear of debris or cave ins
- Mix design confirmed with supplier (psi, slump, additives)
- Pour start time locked in with concrete finisher
- On-site contact confirmed for the day of pour
- Water source available (for cleanup and finishing)
- Designated washout
- Power source available (for tools or lights if early/late)
- Safety gear on-site: cones, barriers, signage
