

Home Showings & the Corona Virus

If you are the seller: For your safety and protection and to promote public health, we suggest you follow these sanitary practices if you are allowing showings of your home. (You do have the right to say no at any time).



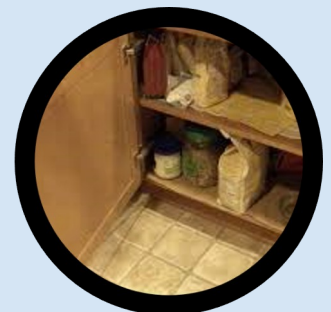
Wipe down all surfaces before and after showings.



If you or a family member is not feeling well, do not have showings



If possible, provide hand sanitizer upon entry for to your home for visitors to use.



Leave cabinet and closet doors, closet doors, and any other spaces a buyer may want to see open.

If you are the buyer: You must be a pre-qualified. Please view all photos, videos and disclosures in advance of asking for a showing. Do a drive-by if possible. Be sure the showing is necessary. Only one person + the real estate agent may enter the home (unless from the same household then more than one is allowed). Plan to drive yourself to the property.*

**If you are from outside of VT, you may NOT be able to come, discuss with your agent first.*



If you are sick, do not schedule showings until after you have been self-quarantined for 14 days and are no longer showing symptoms.



Please bring and plan to wear a face mask or covering.



Wash hands between showings or use hand sanitizer before entering homes



Do not touch surfaces, allow your agent to open and close doors and cabinets as needed.
