CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Three Business Day Cancellation:

I understand that if for any reason I am unable to enter the class, all monies paid will be refunded if requested in writing within three (3) business days after signing an enrollment agreement and making an initial payment.

Cancellation in writing after the three (3) business day cancellation period but before commencement of classes by the student:

Tuition or fees collected in advance of entrance and if the student does not begin classes, the training facility shall retain not more that the \$250.00 registration fee. Refunds for a student who does not begin classes shall be made within 30 days of the start of a course.

I understand WITHDRAWAL AFTER COMMENCEMENT OF CLASSES REFUND POLICY SHALL BE:

- 1. Cancellation due to illness or emergency all monies can be applied if class is rescheduled within 6 months of original course date.
- 2. If course is not rescheduled within 6 months, 50% of all monies paid will be refunded.

MATERIALS:
