Ballenger has some good ideas about searching for materials (*Curious Researcher* 51-63). It would be good to review him on quoting, paraphrasing, and summarizing (106-114).

- ✚ Give us an introduction that includes the author, title, and any background information you can find out about the author or the publication.
- ✚ Summarize the article as accurately as you can.
- ✚ Explain the writer's strategies in getting his point across to his audience.
- ✚ Choose the article's most memorable, quotable phrases and explain how the author uses them to make his point.
- ✚ This should be 2-3 pp., double-spaced. Create a Works Cited entry for the article, and include any other source material you need to consult. Use the proper format of in-text citations. MLA would be best here, but if you want to use APA, feel free.
- ✚ See Ballenger on citing sources in an essay, MLA style (231) and APA style (297).
- ✚ See Ballenger on reading rhetorically (46-48)
