RULES AND AWARDS 2019-2020

SHOW ATTIRE: English Attire: Long sleeve shirt, breeches, boots, helmet **Western Attire:** Long sleeve collared western shirt (tucked in), boots with heel, cowboy hat or helmet. **Under certain weather conditions warm jackets may be added.**

IMPROPER ATTIRE INCLUDES: Baseball Caps, Tennis Shoes & T-shirts which will constitute a disqualification *without a refund*. No open toed shoes in arena or barn area, this applies to EVERYONE. Competitors will be disqualified if they do not wear a show number either on their horse pad or their person during Saturday events.

SHOWMANSHIP: *In the event English Classes end early, Showmanship will not begin before 11am.* Individuals must participate in 1 other English Class or 1 other Western Class for showmanship points to count towards Daily and Series Point; individuals may show in either English or Western attire for this class.

POINTS: All shows will be pointed on a weighted system. Saturday Performance Points will NOT be combined with Sunday Speed Points for ANY AWARDS. Halter will receive daily ribbons for 1st-6th, but points will only count towards End of Series Overall Points for Halter Award. Halter points will not be combined with other points. If show is cancelled due to weather, points are awarded only in classes riders have completed.

RULES:

- *Competitors must enter *at least two classes* in order for points to qualify for any division: English, Western, or Gymkhana.
 - *Competitors must enter *at least two classes* in each division to qualify for overall and reserve overall in English and Western.
 - *Walk/Trot Jr. Sr. or Advanced Amateur **cannot** lope in any class. To lope continuously in speed events will constitute disqualification.
 - *Contestant must attend 4 out of 6 shows to qualify for End of Series Awards. Latigo will count contestants **BEST 4 out of 6 shows.**
 - *Points are based on "Horse/Rider Combo" for English & Western events. Rider may enter each event only once.
 - *Stallions are allowed to enter WBS events by an individual 2 yrs or older. Stallions may be asked to wait outside of the arena if he is acting out or causing other mares to act out. In this event, the competitor will be supplied a stall in the Latigo premises at no charge. If stallion is acting out while showing in the arena, he may be asked to leave, at the judges discretion, for safety of other riders. In this event, stallion will be dismissed from the show for the rest of the day. Latigo's first priority is the safety of *all* riders.
 - *Halter is based on horse/ride combo.
 - *Riders level selection should be based on riders ability not the horse.
 - *Last years Walk/Trot Jr. and Sr., Novice Jr. & Sr. End of Series Buckle Winners may be required to move up to the next level (not including 3rd place winners) at the discretion of show staff. If 5 or more riders competed for the individual's standing, they will be required to move up. Reasons not to move include age or skill level. Individuals should contact show staff for approval to remain at their previous level.
 - ***If rider has ever trained horses, judged, or given lessons they must show age group.**
 - *Decisions of the judge and the show officials will be final. Walk/Trot will not receive a DQ, but will be judged accordingly.
 - *Rider may only show under one 'division' and may not enter a class more than once.
 - *The Winter Buckle Series will follow Latigo Standing Rules and AQHA Rules. Standing rules will always override AQHA rules. AQHA Legal tack is required. Latigo requires Traditional Tack at all times.
 - *Latigo shows are run in a professional manner and are used as a training ground for "breed" shows for horse and/or rider. We expect the same respect and professionalism towards show judge, staff, facility and fellow riders as would be expected at a "breed" show.
- NEW ADVANCED WALK/TROT RULES**
- *Walk/Trot Open **cannot** lope in any class.
 - * This division is designed for those that are proficient at the walk/trot level but cannot lope due to health issues, are experienced riders but do not lope, do not feel comfortable riding at the lope, or do not want to lope.
 - * Amateur riders that qualify for this division are defined as "riders that have not shown, judged, trained or assisted in training a horse for remuneration, monetary or otherwise, either directly or indirectly, nor received remuneration for instructing another person in riding, driving, training or showing a horse."
 - * If a rider has buckled in Walk/Trot Jr. or Sr. and is choosing *not* to move into lope classes, **they must into Advanced Amateur Walk/Trot division.**
 - * Riders that have shown in Age Group or Novice divisions in past show seasons can move into the Advanced Amateur Walk/Trot division the 2019/2020 shoe season only.
 - * *Remember that divisions at Latigo are based on rider's ability not the horse's ability and that Latigo standing rules state riders may only enter a division once.*

NEW GREEN HORSE A & GREEN HORSE B RULES

- ***Green Horse classes are the ONLY classes that will be based on horses ability, not the riders ability.**
- *Any division can enter the Green Horse A & B class with the exception of Walk/Trot riders who must show in the Green Horse A class.
- *Green Horse A will be a ridden rail class that calls for the Walk/Trot. Green Horse B will be a ridden rail class that calls for the Walk/Trot/Lope.
- *These classes will be judged but **DO NOT** count for daily prizes or end of series prizes.
- *Green horse is defined as any horse that is new to showing and has not been ridden under saddle for more than a few years.
- *Green horse may be shown in either English or Western tack.
