**POINTS:** Saturday Performance Points will NOT be combined with Sunday Speed Points for Daily High Points or Series High Points. If show is cancelled due to weather, points are awarded only in classes you have completed.

**Contestant must attend 4 out of the 6 shows to qualify for End of Series Awards. Latigo will count contestants BEST 4 out of 6 shows (all divisions). If a show is canceled, the make-up date is May 5.**

**Barrel time of:  
 18 seconds or better must do Novice  
 17 seconds or better must do Age Group**

**RULES & AWARD PAGE:** Every Contestant must read the Rules and Awards page before entering classes. If unable to understand the rules and awards page a guardian must read and understand the rules before a contestant can enter the competition. Rules are posted on website or available at Latigo Show office.

**Gymkhana Attire:** Long sleeve collared western shirt (tucked in), boots with heel, Cowboy Hat or Helmet. **Under certain weather conditions warm jackets may be allowed.**

# RULES AND AWARDS 2018 – 2019

**SHOW ATTIRE: English Attire:** Long sleeve shirt, breeches, boots, helmet **Western/Gymkhana Attire:** Long sleeve collared western shirt (tucked in), boots with heel, Cowboy Hat or Helmet. **Under certain weather conditions warm jackets may be added.**

**IMPROPER ATTIRE:** Baseball Caps, Tennis Shoes & T-shirts will constitute a disqualification without a refund. No open toed shoes in arena or barn area, this applies to EVERYONE. No show number either worn on horse pad or individual during Saturday events will constitute a DQ.

**SHOWMANSHIP:** In the event English Classes end early, Showmanship will never begin before 11am. You must participate in 1 other English Class or 1 other Western Class for showmanship points to count towards Daily and Series Points. You may show in either English or Western attire.

**POINTS: All shows will be pointed on a weighted system.** Saturday Performance Points will NOT be combined with Sunday Speed Points for ANY AWARDS. Halter will receive special ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>, yet points will only count towards End of Series Overall Points for Halter Award. If show is cancelled due to weather, points are awarded only in classes you have completed.

## RULES:

\*You must enter at least two classes to win in any division: English, Western or Gymkhana.

\*You must enter at least two classes in each division to qualify for overall and reserve overall in English and Western.

\*Gymkhana Events: Hat or helmet must be on head when crossing the Start Line during all speed events. If it falls off before the start line there will be a 5 second penalty. No hat or helmet will be a disqualification.

\*Walk/Trot Jr. or Sr., All Novice, Little Lopers are based on RIDER only, NOT the horse.

\*Walk/Trot Jr. or Sr. **cannot** lope on Saturday or Sunday. To lope continuously in speed events will constitute disqualification.

\*Speed Time Limits: **Little Lopers:** If contestant runs a 18 second barrel run or better, they may be moved up to Novice or receive a 5 second penalty per show management. **Novice:** If contestant runs a 17 second barrel run or better, they may be moved up to age group or receive 5 second penalty per show management ruling. This applies to the first 3 shows the contestant rides in. See Latigo Standing Show rules for details.

\*Contestant must attend 4 out of the 6 shows to qualify for End of Series Awards. Latigo will count contestants BEST 4 out of 6 shows (all divisions).

\*Points are based on "Rider" only for Gymkhana Events. Rider may enter each event only once. There will be NO practice/exhibition runs.

Points are based on "Horse/Rider Combo" for English & Western events. Rider may enter each event only once. (This does not apply to "Open" Reining/Ranch Riding class or Halter)

\*Stallions are allowed to enter WBS events by an individual 21yrs or older. Stallions may be asked to not wait in the arena if he is acting out or causing other mares to act out. In this event, you will be supplied a stall in the Latigo barn at no charge. If stallion is acting out while showing in the arena, he may be asked to leave at the judges discretion for safety of other riders. In this event, stallion will be dismissed from the show for the rest of the day. Latigo's first priority is the safety of all riders.

\*Halter is based on Horse only and points will go towards horse, not horse/rider combo. Anyone may show the horse.

\*Gymkhana: Loss of forward motion is a DQ, except for Walk/Trot who will receive a "severe" penalty - 10 sec.

\*Last years Walk/Trot Jr. and Sr., Little Lopers & Novice Jr. & Sr. End of Series Buckle Winners "may" be required to move up to the following level (not including 3rd place winners). If 5 or more riders competed for your standing, you will be required to move. Reasons not to move ex: age or skill level. Please see show management for approval to not move up to next level. Gymkhana: Passing set time restrictions will supercede all reasoning.

\*AQHA Legal tack is required. Latigo requires Traditional Tack at all times.

\* Latigo Shows are run in a professional manner and are used as a training ground for "breed" shows for horse and/or rider. We expect the same respect and professionalism towards show judge, staff, facility and fellow riders as would be expected at a "breed" show.

\*If rider has ever trained horses or given lessons for any amount of pay they must show age group.

\*Decisions of the judge and the show officials will be final. Walk/Trot will not receive a DQ, yet will be judged accordingly.

\*We will follow Latigo Standing Rules and AQHA Rules. Standing rules will always override AQHA rules.
