RULES AND AWARDS 2024-2025

SHOW ATTIRE: English Attire: Long sleeve shirt, show coat, or jacket, breeches, boots, helmet. Western Attire: Long sleeve shirt, vest, or jacket, boots with heel, cowboy hat or helmet. IMPROPER ATTIRE INCLUDES: Baseball Caps, Tennis Shoes, Hoodies & T-shirts which will constitute a disqualification *without a refund*. No open toed shoes in the arena or barn area, this applies to EVERYONE.

SHOWMANSHIP: *In the event English Classes end early, Showmanship will not begin before 10 AM.* Individuals must participate in 1 other English Class or other Western Class for showmanship points to count towards Daily/Series Point; individuals may show in either English or Western attire for this class.

POINTS: <u>All shows will be pointed on a weighted system</u>. Halter will receive daily ribbons for 1st-6th, but points will only count towards End of Series Overall Points for Halter Award. If the show is canceled due to weather, points are awarded only in classes riders have completed. **Points are based on "Horse/Rider Combo" for English & Western events. Riders may enter each event only once.**

RULES:

- *Competitors must enter at least two classes in order for points to qualify for any division: English, Western, or Gymkhana.
- *Competitors must enter at least two classes in each division to qualify for overall and reserve overall in English and Western.
- *Walk/Trot Jr, Sr, or Advanced Amateur cannot lope in any class.
- *Contestants must attend 4 out of 6 shows to qualify for End of Series Awards. Latigo will count contestants BEST 4 out of 6 shows. In the event of show cancellation, please reference the standing rules for policies/procedures.
- *Stallions are allowed to enter WBS events by an individual 21 yrs or older. Stallions may be asked to wait outside of the arena if he is acting out or causing other mares to act out. In this event, the competitor will be supplied a stall at no charge. If a stallion is acting out while showing in the arena, he may be asked to leave, at the judges discretion, for the safety of other riders. In this event, the stallion will be dismissed for the rest of the day. Latigo's first priority is the safety of *all* riders.
- *Horses must be new to showing (less than 3 years) to qualify for the green horse class.
- *Last year's Walk/Trot Jr. and Sr., Novice Jr. & Sr. End of Series Buckle Winners will be required to move up to the next level (not including 3rd place winners) if 5 or more riders competed for the individual's standing and at the discretion of show staff. Reasons not to move include age or skill level and may be discussed prior to entering. Individuals should contact show staff for approval.
- *Decisions of the judge and the show officials will be final. Walk/Trot will not receive a DQ, but will be judged accordingly. Novice and Age Group classes are able to be DQ for certain penalties as stated in AQHA Rules.
- *Riders may only show under one 'division' and may not enter a class more than once. Riders will NOT be able to enter any classes under a "non-judged" status. Practice classes will not be allowed. If you are interested in schooling, enter Green Horse.
- *The Winter Buckle Series will follow Latigo Standing Rules and AQHA Rules. Standing rules will always override AQHA rules. AQHA Legal tack is required. Latigo requires Traditional Tack at all times.
- *Latigo shows are run in a professional manner and are used as a training ground for "breed" shows for horse and/or rider. We expect the same respect and professionalism towards the show judge, staff, facility and fellow riders as would be expected at a "breed" show. Interrupting a judge during the event is prohibited, waiting to get feedback at the conclusion of the show is appropriate.
- * In the event of a change, checks will not be cashed until after shows. A \$25 fee will be applied for all returned checks.
- *Walk/Trot Advanced Amateur is designed for those that are proficient at the walk/trot level but cannot lope due to health issues, are experienced riders but do not lope, do not feel comfortable riding at the lope, or do not want to lope. You cannot lope and you MUST show one handed in this division. If a rider has buckled in Walk/Trot Jr. or Sr. and is choosing *not* to move into lope classes, **they must enter the**Advanced Amateur Walk/Trot division.
- **Daily prizes will be awarded to riders earning High Point and Reserve High Point in each division. All leadline riders will receive a prize and first place participation ribbon.
