

Brooklyn BCA Player Code of Conduct

1. Unsportsmanlike conduct WILL NOT BE TOLERATED! NO EXCEPTIONS!

Said player (s) will forfeit any and all prize money that may be due or owed.

2. It is the player's sole responsibility to know all of the rules for the format that they are participating in. Please refer to <https://www.playcsipool.com/bcapl-rules.html> for clarification.

3. All player's are required to adhere to any and all house rules posted by, or verbally instructed by management. Player's are forbidden from attempting to jump a ball, with or without a jump cues. Any damages that is caused by, or suspected to have been caused by, any player, or guest of any player, said damages will be paid to management out of the tournament prize fund.

4. Player must be at their tables, and ready to play, within 10 minutes of the opening set. Players have 5 minutes for all additional sets.

5. Only (1) 5 minute Rest period permitted, and this rest may only be taken on said player's turn to break. Violators will be penalized a lose of game.

6. If the (TD) determines that player (s) are slow playing, whether intentional or not, a warning will be issued. If the situation continues, the (TD) will either move the match to a table closer to the TD desk and/or implement a 45 second shot clock.

7. No cellphones, blue tooth, ear buds, or any electronic devices are **NOT** allowed during match play, regardless of whether the opposing player gives permission. Player(s) who violate this rule will forfeit their match.

8. BEFORE the shot is taken, it is encouraged that the (TD) or a referee is called if there's a possibility of a foul or for a rule clarification. In the absence of such, the shot will always go to the shooter.

9. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED.**

10. NO Gambling prior to your set, on your set, or on or with any participant or spectator. Violators will forfeit their match and any and all prize money.

11) Prior to the event, the TD will review all rules, modifications, host location requirements and answer any and all questions. Arriving late, and missing the player instruction meeting, is no excuse for a later violation.
