

11. Roster Changes / Adding New Players (BCAPL and USAPL)

Players cannot be added to the roster after week 4 of play in the Summer session, and after 6 weeks during the Fall and Winter sessions without permission from the League Director or League Operator.

12. Proof of Identity (BCAPL and USAPL)

All players must be able to provide proof of their identity prior to the start of any match. Failure to comply will be interpreted as Unsportsmanlike conduct, and treated as same.

13. Unsportsmanlike Conduct (BCAPL and USAPL)

The guidelines for unsportsmanlike conduct are outlined in the *Official CSI Rules* on page 93. This includes, but is not limited to, actions that are seen as to be embarrassing, disruptive, and/or detrimental to other players, spectators, league and/or event officials or to the sport in general.

14. Penalties for Unsportsmanlike Conduct (BCAPL and USAPL)

Exact penalties will be determined by the League Operator, and/or League Manager. These penalties may range from a warning to suspension / expulsion from the league, disqualification from a tournament or playoffs, and forfeiture of prize money won during the regular or post session.

15. Sandbagging Policies (BCAPL and USAPL)

This league will not tolerate "sandbagging" (playing at a skill level below a player's true ability in order to manipulate and gain an unfair advantage) of any kind. The League Operator, and or League Manager, reserves the right to manually adjust any player's rating at any time if sandbagging is suspected. League Operator is not required to notify or warn said player, or his/her team captain that they are suspected of sandbagging. Repeated offenses **WILL** result in suspension or expulsion from the league and registration of said action to Cue Sport International. If a player is found to have attempted to, or to actually have "sandbagged" and the League Operator has taking action against the player or team, THERE IS NO RIGHT OF APPEAL.

16. Slow Play, use of Shot Clock

The Brooklyn BCA Pool Leagues is a amateur league, and we encourage our players to have fun, play at a reasonable pace and enjoy the overall experience. There may be a rare occasion where a **Team Captain** feels that a player is taking longer than the customary 30 to 45 seconds that the average player takes per shot. The Brooklyn BCA Pool Leagues welcomes players of all skill levels and ability, however The League must address such situations as fairly and diplomatically as possible. The **TEAM Captain** must Quietly raise their concerns to the other **Team's Captain** and allow some time for the situation to correct itself. If the player in question fails to play at a reasonable pace, BEFORE the next rack is started, and for the remainder of the match, BOTH players will be placed on a 45 second shot clock. Each player will be permitted only ONE 45 second extension for the remainder of the match. Team Captains will be responsible for timekeeping. If the cueball is not in motion before the timer sounds, then the shot is considered null, pocketed balls will be spotted, and the incoming player receives BIH. If the foul occurred, and the game winning ball was pocketed, it is a loss of game.

17. Brooklyn BCA League and USA Pool League of NYC By-Laws.

All team captains will be issued a copy of the League's By-Laws, via email. It is the sole responsibility of the team captains to read, understand and educate their players. The onus for the knowledge of, and the distribution of the contents contained within the By-Laws and the rules, rests solely with the team captain.
