



Mohawk Valley Trout Unlimited Strategic Plan 2026-2028

Mission: A multifaceted effort to protect aquatic ecosystems through a combination of hands-on conservation, community involvement, and a commitment to ensuring the long-term survival of cold-water fisheries in the Mohawk Valley, southern Tug Hill region and Adirondack foothills.

Chapter Goals - Cold-water fisheries, Community Engagement and Youth Education

Conservation, Protection, and Restoration: Focus on the health of the Mohawk Valley, lower Tug Hill and Adirondack Foothills cold-water fisheries and the watersheds they depend on.

Science-Based Approaches: Use scientific principles to set current stream baselines and find solutions to conservation challenges.

Landscape Approach: Focus on connected river systems to improve their resilience against events like droughts, and floods.

Community Engagement: Bring together local residents to actively participate in repairing and renewing local rivers and streams.

Community-Focused Actions: Engage in local conservation projects, community events, and educational programs.

Connecting People to Rivers: Foster a deeper connection between communities and their local water bodies.

Future Generations: Teach children the impact of water quality on the health of fish and wildlife through hands on learning experiences and provide opportunities to increase their connection to our local streams

Strategy: Develop a new engagement model that expands the corps of volunteers, partners, supporters, and advocates taking action to care for and recover our local waters.

Objectives and Actions:

1. Increase volunteer leaders and chapter membership

Enhance monthly gathering experience and participation – new venue and subjects

Engage new and lapsed members – membership coordinator

Create more opportunities for community and member involvement – fun and work events

Active recruitment by board and long-term members

Advocate student chapter memberships through local colleges and universities.

2. Increase events with community participation - monthly activities and annual calendar plan

MVTURKS – stream monitoring – equipment funding primarily via raffle and CNY Fly-Tying Symposium

Community and volunteer involvement events – board leads - 1 event per year, annual calendar

Advocacy – local governments and community events – advocacy coordinator

Engage other community groups by outreach to companies and organizations.

3. **Increase Trout in the Classroom and Conservation participation of local schools**
 - Recruit and train 8-10 active volunteers (3-5 classrooms/volunteer)
 - Promote TIC to grow to 25- 30 classrooms
 - Adequate funding primarily via raffle and CNY Fly-Tying Symposium for chillers, equipment, field trips
 - Additional field trips – hatcheries and streamside events (even w/o TIC)
4. **Develop a set of local promotional tools for local print and social media – publicity lead**
 - Build a list of periodical and media contacts for event promotion – send for each event and gathering
 - Newsletter and blog or periodic articles on conservation topics
 - Develop connections to engage political leaders, other organizations, govt agencies, and companies in events
5. **Target watershed – Oriskany Creek 5-year comprehensive improvement plan**
 - Assess current health status and potential improvements
 - Seek participation from key stakeholders (DEC, local govt, adjacent landowners, public, other non-profits, state/national TU)
 - Develop and implement action plan to improve water quality, ecosystem health, angler and visitor experience.


