The New York State Council is proud to host the 2026 Trout Water Youth Camp at Camp Amahami, NY. This is near Deposit, NY on the West Branch of Delaware River at Hale Eddy, NY. The Camp will start Sunday, June 28th and conclude Friday, July 3rd 2026.

The Delaware River

The Delaware River system is composed of the East Branch, West Branch, and Main Stem of the Delaware River. The entire system is influenced by cold water releases from two large New York City reservoirs, the Pepacton and Canonsville dams. These dams produce one of the top tail water trout fisheries East of the Rockies. The cold water produces heavy insect hatches supporting a trophy trout population. This combination attracts fly fishers from all over the country. The fishing is rarely easy here, but anglers have the opportunity to catch wild fish famous for their strength and fighting ability. Students will get to fish various areas in the Delaware system and hone their skills on some of the most selective trout found anywhere.
