

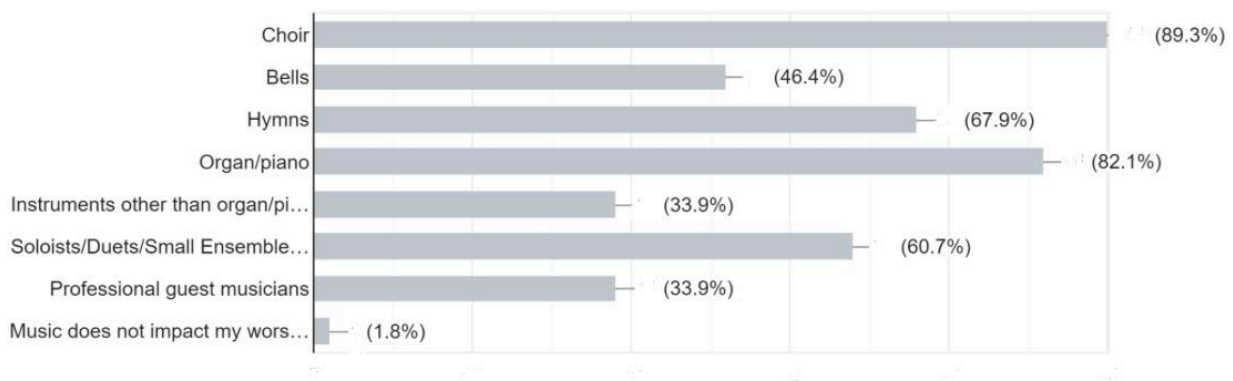
FCC Music Committee Survey

Which parts of the service do you most prefer?

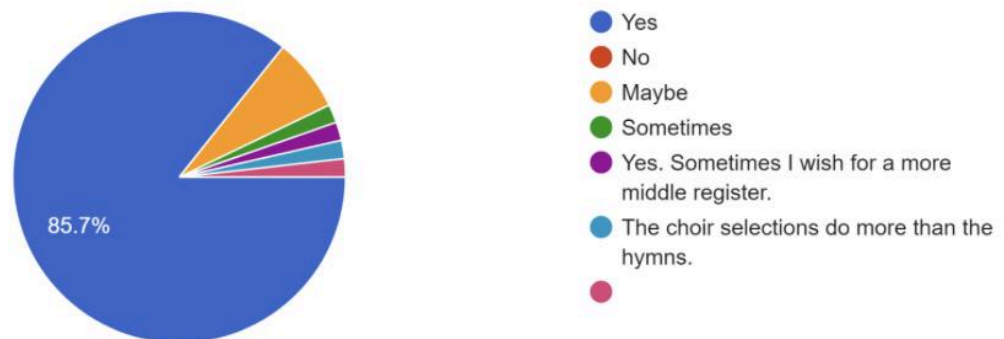
56 responses



For the singing of hymns at our church, many favorites were mentioned among the options which people were invited to list. Of the respondents, 85.7% agree that "our music selections uplift them spiritually". Some individuals made suggestions requesting more variety, more spirituals, and more contemporary music.

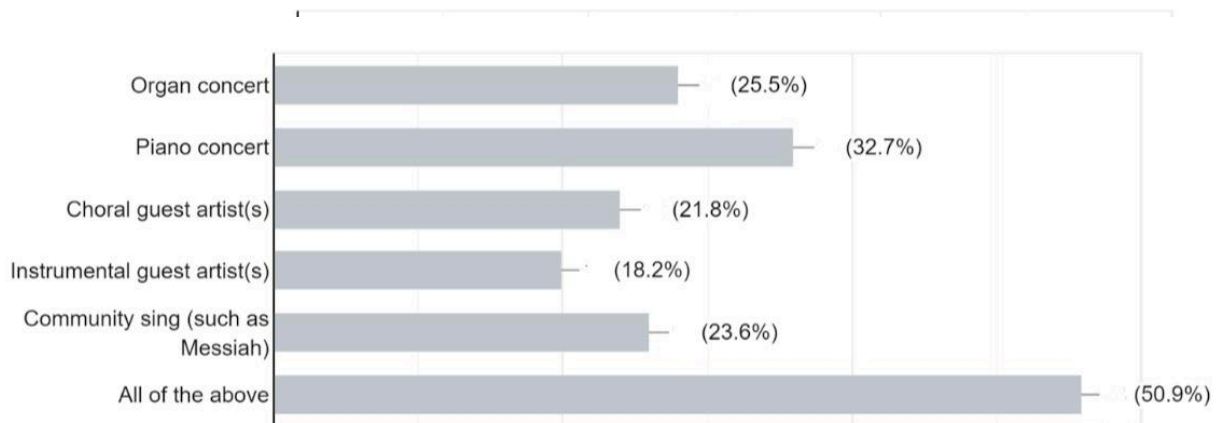


Many people responded to how we can share our ministry with people unable to attend worship or other events. Mainly the answers were to continue with live streaming, to continue with the Outreach Singers, to make home visits, and to have concerts.

In response to what will help our music ministry encourage newcomers to more fully experience God's presence, several people referred to the annual or bi-annual giving of special concerts, such as was done with the Requiem and the Gloria.

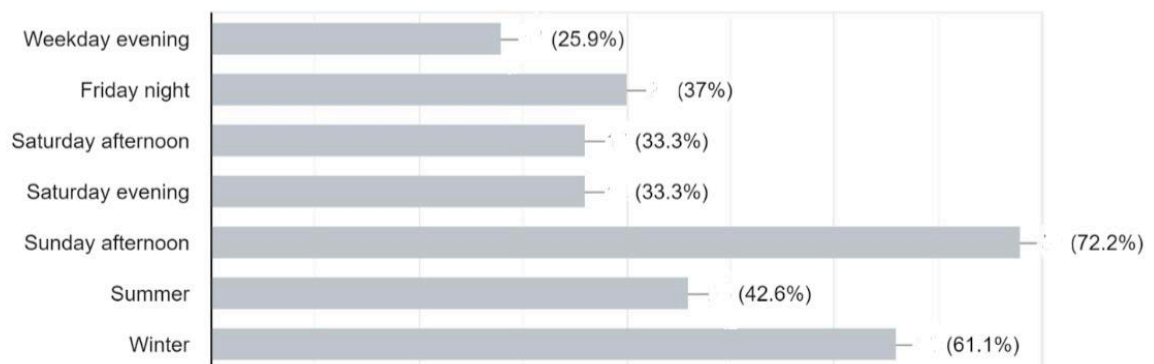
What kind of musical concert/event would you likely attend in our church outside of services?
