The Flood City Youth Fitness Academy will hold our grand opening of the CODE 4 STEM Academy with Communi-TEAMS "Family Night" on Tuesday, October 25th from 4:00pm to 6:00pm for families and students enrolled in the FCYFA, Safe Haven After-School program and the families of the 70 students currently enrolled in the CODE4 STEM Academy located at 200 Lincoln Street, downtown Johnstown.

The CODE 4 STEM Academy opened October 3rd. The program theme for October is "Games". They will also experience next month's theme: The "Science of Sports"

The theme for our CommuniTEAMS "Family Night" is COMMUNITY! Our middle school students have planned a family scavenger hunt and Communi-TEAMS has planned fun activities and refreshments for help students learn about the community in Johnstown, where they live and how connected we are connected as community of Johnstown. CommuniTEAMS is a Pitt-Johnstown diversity program initiative that provides STEAM programming to Johnstown youth, with opportunities for Pitt-Johnstown college students to serve as mentors.
