Left has no logic

Sir: The report 'Left logic: then and now' (IE, Dec.21) has exposed the political opportunism of the Indian Communists. While Communism all over the world is dying, comrades here are desperately trying to survive by presenting themselves as champions of Indian unity and secularism. The report clearly gives details of the equivocal approach of the Communists on the issue of invoking article 356 of the Parliament (to the BJP ruled State Governments).
