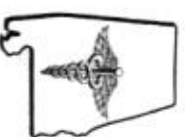

Thank you for choosing **Alabama Infectious Disease Center** infusion clinic to help meet your medical needs.

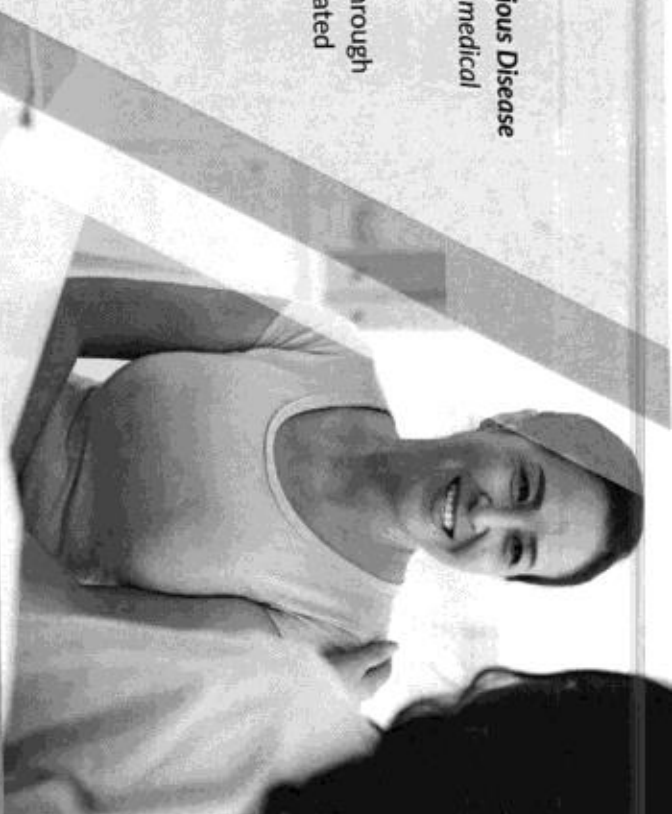

## Physician Referral Process

Before starting your infusion therapy at AIDC Infusion Clinic, you will see one of our physicians to coordinate care. In addition to caring for you throughout your treatment, our team works with the referring physician to ensure the best treatment outcomes.
