

Critter Corner

We have seen a lot of press lately about the migration of Monarch butterflies, and how we need to help ensure that both host plant and food plants are available along their route. It is common to see orange and black butterflies flitting from milkweed plant to plant. Not all such butterflies, though, are Monarchs. In the picture we see an imposter, not a Monarch, but rather a Viceroy. Monarchs, because of their milkweed diet, taste bad to birds. Viceroys take advantage of their camouflage to avoid predation. Since the two species are so similar, how are we (and birds) to tell the difference? Viceroys have a thin black line parallel to the heavy outer band on the rear wings. Also, the large spots on the ends of the front wings are yellow on Monarchs and white on Viceroys. Still confused? Probably best not to eat any orange and black butterflies.
