#### **LETTER FROM BILL ISON:**

Following a near fatal accident with my farm tractor, I am glad to report I am back home after surgery to repair damage to my left foot & ankle, followed by 10 days of recovery and rehab in the hospital. It will be several weeks before I will be allowed to bear weight on my left leg and more will be known about my long term prognosis after the doctor removes the temporary cast from my left foot & ankle and evaluates the results in a couple of weeks but, I think the prognosis is good:-).

As the tractor wheel slowly rolled over my body during the accident, I sincerely thought I was experiencing the last few seconds of my life. In your interest, and the interest of all of the people who care about you, I **STRONGLY** encourage all of you to never, ever, exit any kind of motorized vehicle (tractor, auto, riding mower or ???) while the engine is running, regardless of all safety features. The only truly safe thing to do is to stop the engine any time you leave a motorized vehicle/machine. A seemingly harmless machine with an idling engine can transform into a dangerous killing machine in the blink of an eye.

I have been pleasantly surprised and pleased by all the cards, phone calls and electronic messages I have received from so many of you. I want you to know how much I appreciate all of them individually and collectively.

I am so thankful that I have been given an opportunity to spend more of my life accomplishing more good things with good folks like you. I am REALLY AND TRULY looking forward to seeing all of my friends in the future.

#### **Horse Daze**

Mark your calendar to attend the fifth annual Horse Daze event at beautiful Sebald Park on September 17<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM, rain or shine! Horse Daze is the result of a collaborative effort between Metro Parks of Butler County and the Butler County Chapter of the Ohio Horseman's Council. This wonderful event provides children of all ages and their families a unique opportunity to experience the joy of horses. Attendance has grown each year and this year's event will be designed to accommodate increased attendance.

Separate horseback riding areas will be provided for riders of different ages or skill levels, including the Tiny Tots riding area, which will feature minis & ponies where adults can walk beside the rider.

Activities will include tractor-drawn hayrides, a photo station for riders, demonstrations to include riding skills, grooming, hoof trimming and tack information. Additionally, the popular Kid's Corral area will feature lots of horse-related kid's

activities, face painting, and will introduce Straw Bale Mountain to climb and play on. Food and drinks will be available for purchase at reasonable prices or bring your own picnic meal and utilize one of the many shelters available in the park.

All possible precautionary measures are taken to ensure participant safety, per Ohio Equine Law, participants assume the risk inherent in attending or participating in equine activities.

All event activities will be provided free of charge, however a Motor Vehicle Permit is required. Motor Vehicle Permit FREE to Butler County Residents. Non-Residents \$5/daily or \$10/annual. Volunteers for the event will receive an event volunteer parking pass.
