


#### **Dear Community Rewards Organization:**

## **Proposed By-Laws Changes**

The Board of Directors has requested a change in the current by-laws of the corporation. All changes in the by-laws must be approved by a majority vote of the membership at the annual meeting to be held on April 12.

## As currently written:

Article III \_ Section 3- Number, Term of Office and Qualification:

- a. The number of Directors of the Friends of MetroParks of Butler County shall be not less than seven or greater than fifteen.
- b. Directors shall be elected by the general membership to serve as members of the governing Board for no more than two terms of three (3) years each consecutively.
- c. One-third of the Board of Directors shall be elected annually to serve for 3 years in staggered terms such that one-third are elected annually.
- d. Those serving two terms must be then off the board for at least one year before being voted for additional terms.
- e. All members of the Board of directors shall be members of good standing during their term of office.

## **Proposed change:**

Article III \_ Governance: Section 3-Number, Term of Office and Oualification:

a. The number of Directors of the Friends of MetroParks of Butler County

shall be not less than seven or greater than fifteen.

- b. Directors shall be elected by the general membership for a term of three (3) years to serve as members of the governing Board. for no more than two terms of three (3) years each consecutively.
- c. One-third of the Board of Directors shall be elected annually to serve for 3 years in staggered terms such that one-third are elected annually.
- d. Those serving two terms must be then off the board for at least one year before being voted for additional terms.
- d. e.All members of the Board of directors shall be members of good standing during their term of office.

## **Final Reading**

Article III \_ Governance: Section 3-Number, Term of Office and Qualification:

- a. The number of Directors of the Friends of MetroParks of Butler County shall be not less than seven or greater than fifteen.
- b. Directors shall be elected by the general membership for a term of three (3) years to serve as members of the governing Board.
- c. One-third of the Board of Directors shall be elected annually to serve for 3 years in staggered terms such that one-third are elected annually.
- d. All members of the Board of directors shall be members of good standing during their term of office.

## **Critter Corner**

Here's a bird I spotted last week. In size, somewhere between a warbler and a finch. Stripes of black, white, and yellow were in evidence. While not obvious from this picture, the bird wears a small mask of red. It eats thistle seeds and small insects. Since it was the first week of spring, it can be assumed that plumage was ready for courtship.

Who can identify this beauty? Perhaps I should have mentioned that the tree branch on which she sits belongs to an olive tree, and that said tree was on the slope below the church of St. Francis of Assisi in Italy. I confess that this is a female goldfinch (European goldfinch, that is). The male has similar coloration, but with a larger red mask on the face.

Many other of the local birds were much more familiar to the wandering American birder, including English sparrows, rock doves (pigeons), ring-neck doves, ring-neck pheasants, egrets, grey herons (very similar to the great blue heron), laughing gulls, and herring gulls. Amazing how many invasive species there are on this old Earth (including the author).



Are you interested in the health of our local streams? If so, join Butler Soil and Water Conservation District and MetroParks of Butler County to learn about the biology of streams. After a brief background on streams, water quality, and the stream creatures, we will enter the creek to conduct a stream sample. This biological sample will help us to assess the health of the water. Interested attendees can become samplers for the Butler County Stream Team, a local water quality citizen science group.
