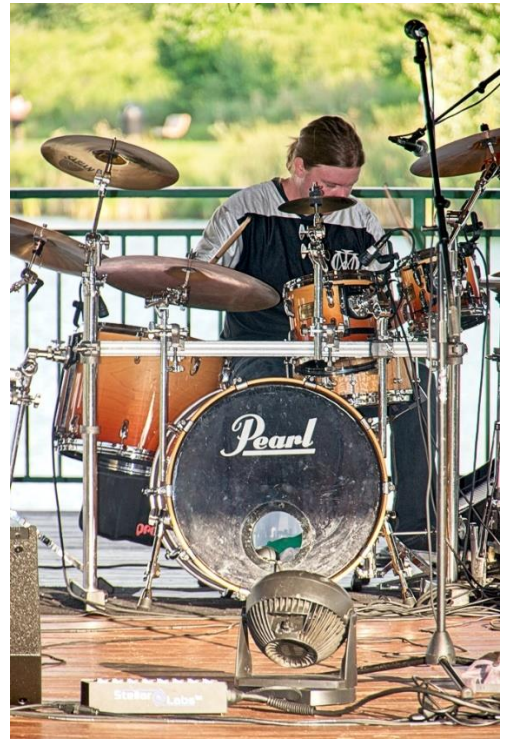

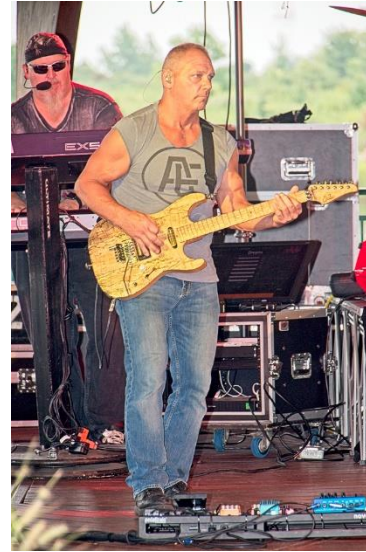

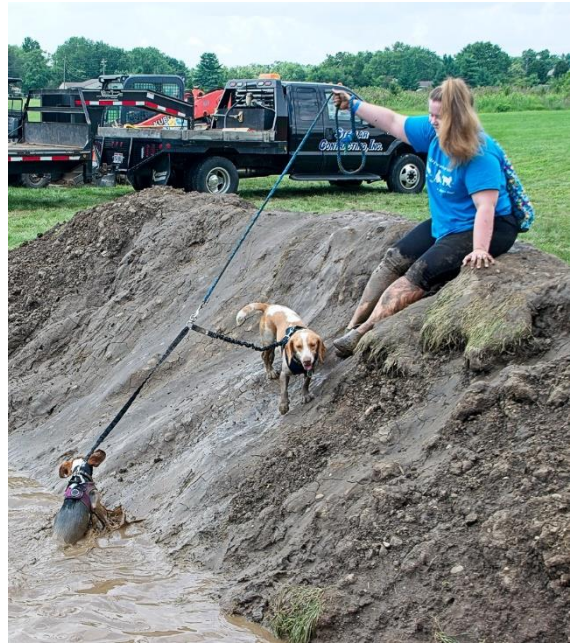

over 2,270 personal interactions with our park customer/owners.

Despite hot temperatures, the Crazy Cardboard Boat Regatta was a hit with all 1,500 spectators and participants that came out, and next year we will celebrate the event's 10th year.



Mud Mania wrapped up with a new twist to the event, Mutt Mania! 50 dogs came out to roll around in the mud and all 2,000 participants were happy and muddy by the end of the weekend.

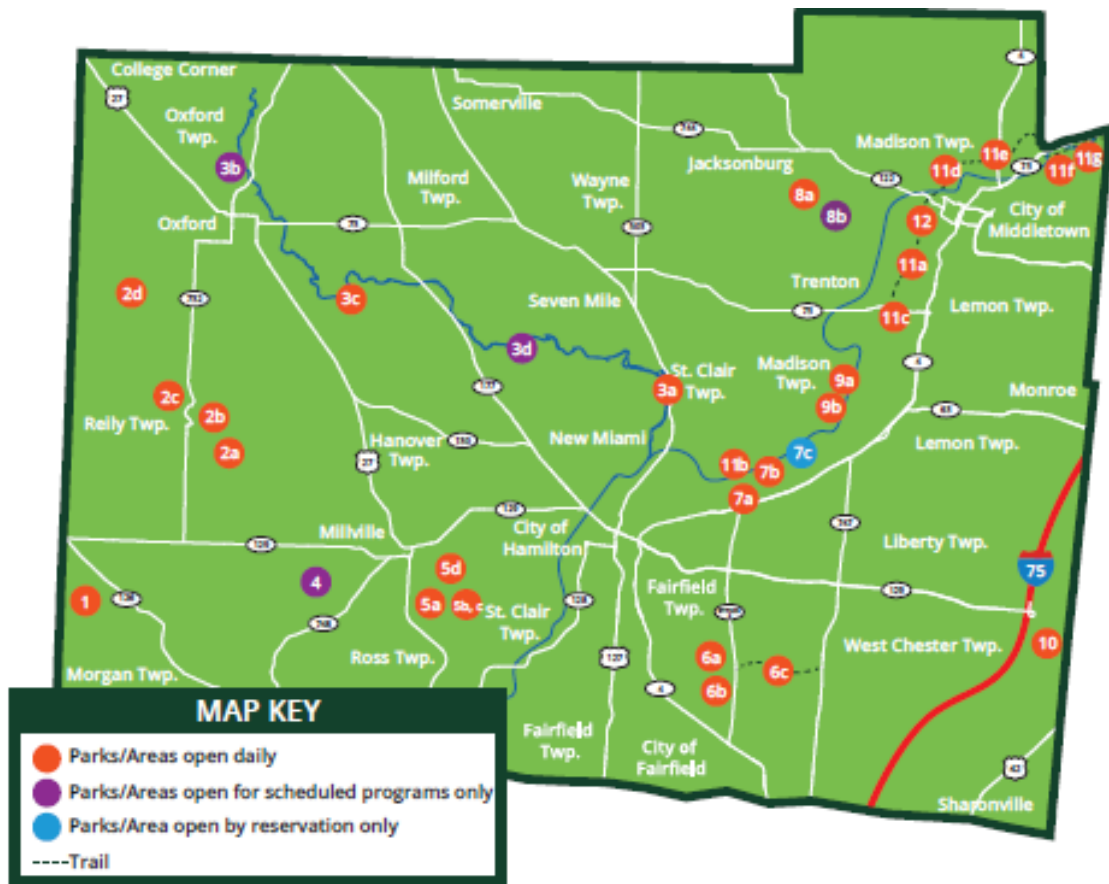

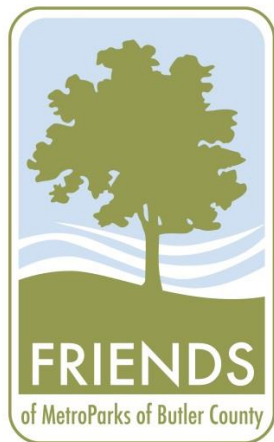
