



## How to Fly A Drone

- **The Camera** is in the **Front** of the Drone. When flying forward, the drone always flies in the direction the camera is facing.
- **The Battery** is in the **Back** of the Drone.



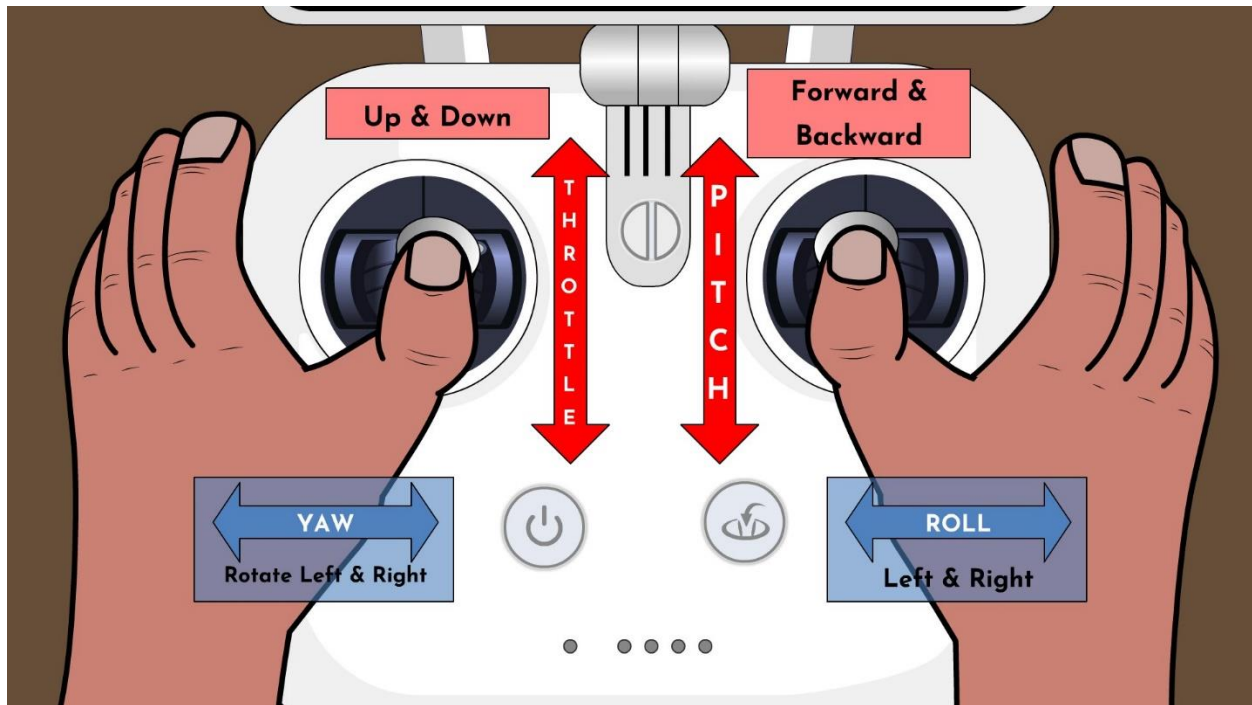
- **Stand Behind the Drone** with the Drone Facing Away from you before Take-Off.



- When you are behind the drone, left is *left* and right is *right*.
- When you turn the drone around so it is facing you; left becomes *right* and right becomes *left*.
- To avoid confusion, we **ALWAYS** refer to the **DRONE's** left and right; not the pilot's.



Drone Remote Controller (RC) Function			
Navigational Term	Stick	Stick Movement	Drone Flies
THROTTLE	Left	Up & Down	Up & Down
YAW	Left	Left & Right	Rotates Left & Right
PITCH	Right	Up & Down	Forward & Backward
ROLL	Right	Left & Right	Left & Right



Here are some basic rules for drones, made by the FAA, to keep us all safe!

- **Never fly your drone above 400 feet.**
- **Don't fly within five miles of an airport.**
- **Don't fly over people.**
- **Don't fly over moving vehicles.**
- **Always maintain a Visual Line of Sight with your drone.**
- **Don't fly at night.**
