The Biewer Terrier (pronounced “Bee-vair”) is a rare and elegant toy breed, developed from the Yorkshire Terrier in the 1980s in Germany. Recognized for their unique tri-color coat — usually white, black/blue, and gold — Biewers are tiny bundles of joy with huge personalities.

Care Tips for Your Biewer

Grooming:

- Daily brushing for long coats
- Regular baths (every 2–3 weeks)
- Short “puppy cuts” make maintenance easier

Exercise:

- Short daily walks
- Playtime indoors or in the yard
- Mental stimulation (puzzle toys, training)

Feeding:

- High-quality, small-breed food
- 2–3 meals per day

- Monitor for hypoglycemia in puppies

Health Watch:

- Patellar luxation
- Dental care is a must
- Regular vet checkups are recommended
