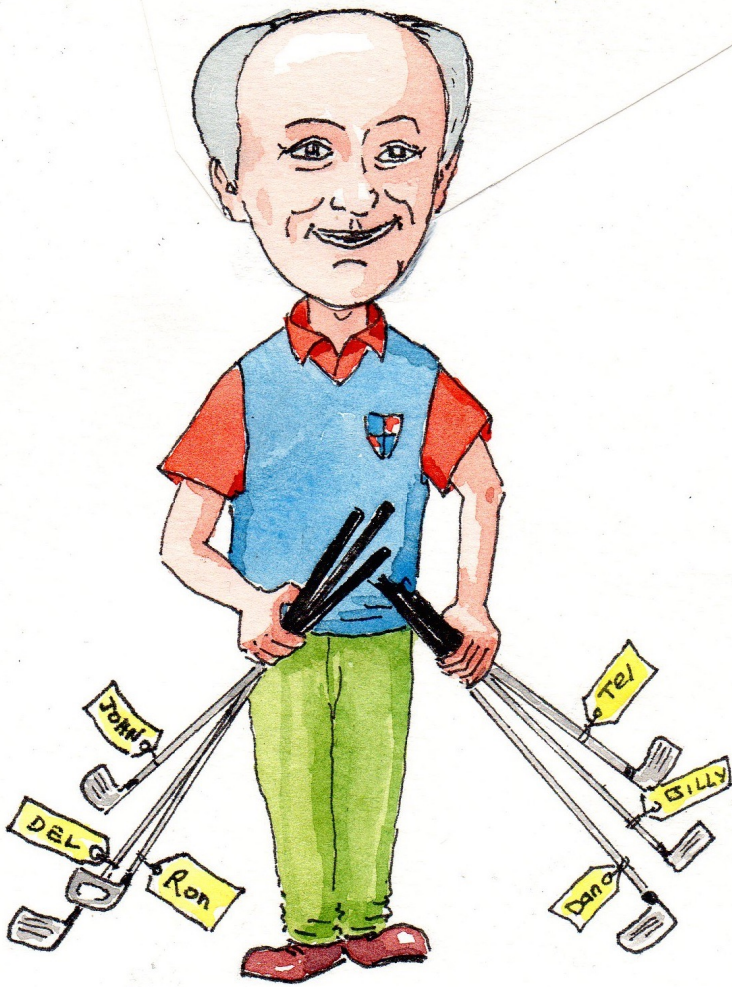


Famous Wanstead Veterans
