

Owners Manual Boat Lift Sunshade Canopy

Thank you for your recent purchase of your Golden Sunshade canopy, we appreciate your business and support. Please read the owner's manual carefully as it provides vital information on safety, operation and maintenance of your Sunshade system. Refer to www.goldensunshade.com/warranty for complete warranty guidelines.



- Canopy tops are designed with a convenient bungee system to be removable. These canopy tops MUST be removed when winds are to exceed 70MPH or before prolonged periods of snowfall where snow buildup can occur (unless your canopy has been specifically designed for snow load). If the canopy top is not removed before winds reach these speeds, serious personal injury or damage to the frame or surrounding objects may occur. Failure to remove the canopy top will void the warranty and we will not be liable for any damage/injury sustained as a result. If you are not able to remove the canopy top on your own, please call your local dealer.
- WARNING
- Bungees are attached through the grommets of the canopy straps and are designed to hold the canopy top tightly and securely to the frame. Bungees are a wearable component and will require regular replacement to maintain effectiveness. We require bungees to be replaced every 2 years or when there is significant wear (loss of elasticity, breakage, etc.), whichever is sooner. Significantly worn bungees have reduced strength and may limit their ability to hold the canopy top securely to the frame. High wind events with unsecured or loosely secured canopy tops will increase the risk of damage to the canopy top itself, the frame, damage to surrounding objects, or personal injury. Failure to replace bungees at the specified time frame or when significantly worn will void the warranty and we will not be liable for any damage or injury sustained as a result. If you are not able to replace the bungees on your own, please call your local dealer.



• While our vinyl canopy tops are waterproof, flame, mildew, stain, and dirt resistant, no material is impervious to all hazards. Proper cleaning and maintenance are important to extend the life of your vinyl top. Dirt accumulation can be unsightly and create an environment for increased mildew growth. Occasional hosing with water will prevent most dirt accumulation. To remove dirt in more extreme cases, apply an 80/20 solution of water and liquid dish soap using a soft brush or cloth in circular motions thoroughly to clean the necessary area. If removing canopy top for storage, allow to dry completely before folding, and store in a cool area. Replace bungees at specified timeframe or when significantly worn to reduce risk of damage to vinyl canopy top caused by high wind events.



Due to being exposed to the elements, damage to the frame, bungees, or straps can occur
unknowingly. Regular wear is also expected over long periods of time. To protect against
unnecessary damage or personal injury, we recommend a visual inspection of your Sunshade canopy
every 6-12 months. Check all connection points, bungees, and straps for any signs of significant
wear or breakage that is of concern. Upon discovery of any areas of concern, please call your
local dealer.
