## **Privacy Policy**

*This document describes how FAR Law, LLC collects, uses and protects information submitted through [farlawllc.com](http://farlawllc.com).*

FAR Law, LLC (“FAR Law” or “the firm”) is committed to protecting the privacy of individuals who visit the website at farlawllc.com (the “Website”) or contact the firm. This policy explains what information is collected, how it is used, and how it is protected.

## **Scope**

This Privacy Policy applies to information collected through the Website and through communications initiated through the Website (including the Contact form and emails sent to addresses displayed on the Website).

This Privacy Policy does not change or limit any duties of confidentiality that may apply under professional responsibility rules or other law once an attorney–client relationship is formed.

## **No attorney–client privilege**

Using the Website, submitting information through the Contact form, or sending the firm an email does not by itself create an attorney–client relationship. Do not send sensitive, confidential, or time-sensitive information through the Contact form unless and until the firm confirms in writing that it represents you.

## **Information the firm collects**

### **Information you provide to the firm**

Your name, email address, phone number (if provided), organization name (if provided), and the contents of your message.

### **Device and usage information**

Information collected by the Website using standard website functions provided by a host services provider, such as IP addresses, browser type, device identifiers, operating system, approximate location derived from IP address, pages viewed, and the date/time of access.

### **Security and anti-spam information**

Information used to help detect automated traffic, abuse, or fraud through use of the Contact form.

The firm does not intentionally collect payment card information through the Website.

## **How the firm uses information**

The firm uses information collected through the Website for the following purposes:

To respond to inquiries and communicate with you about your request

To evaluate potential engagements, including conducting conflict checks and determining whether the firm can assist

To operate, maintain, and secure the Website, including preventing spam and abuse

To comply with legal professional obligations, including recordkeeping and responding to lawful requests

### **Third-party services (hosting and antispam)**

The firm may use third-party service providers to host the Website, support website functionality, and protect the Website from spam or abuse. When you submit information through the Contact form, certain information may be processed by these providers as part of providing security and website services.

### **GoDaddy host services**

#### **Information collected automatically by GoDaddy**

The Website is hosted and maintained through GoDaddy. As part of standard website operations, GoDaddy may collect technical information such as your IP address, browser type, device type, general location (city or region), pages visited, and the time and duration of your visit. This information is used for basic site performance, security, and reliability. The firm does not use this information for marketing or advertising.

#### **Information submitted through the Contact form**

If you submit information through the Contact form, GoDaddy processes the information you provide (such as your name, email address, and message) and delivers it to the firm. A copy may also be stored in the Website's administrative dashboard. This information is used solely to respond to your inquiry. It is not shared with third parties for marketing or advertising.

GoDaddy's services are subject to the GoDaddy Privacy Policy and the GoDaddy Universal Terms of Service Agreement.

### **reCAPTCHA and security**

The Contact form is protected by Google reCAPTCHA to prevent spam and automated abuse. Use of reCAPTCHA is subject to the Google Privacy Policy and Google Terms of Service. reCAPTCHA may collect device information, interaction data (mouse movements, clicks, timing), and technical identifiers (IP address, browser type) for security purposes.

### **How the firm shares information**

The firm does not sell your personal information. The firm may share information in the following circumstances:

Service providers who help the firm operate the Website or the business (such as hosting, IT, security, and email providers), subject to appropriate confidentiality and security expectations

Professional advisers (such as accountants, consultants, or other advisers) as needed for business operations, subject to confidentiality obligations

Legal and compliance disclosures when the firm determines that disclosure is required by law, court order, subpoena, or other legal process, or is necessary to protect rights, safety, and security

Business transfers if the firm engages in a merger, acquisition, reorganization, or sale of assets, in which case information may be transferred as part of that transaction

## **Do not submit confidential information**

Do not submit confidential, sensitive, or time-sensitive information through the Website. No attorney–client relationship is formed unless and until the firm agrees to represent you in writing.

Communications sent through the Website may be treated as confidential to the extent required by applicable professional obligations, but they may not be privileged unless an attorney–client relationship exists and the communication otherwise qualifies for privilege protection.

## **Data security**

The firm uses reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect information collected through the Website. No method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is completely secure, and the firm cannot guarantee absolute security.

## **Data retention**

Information submitted through the Contact form may be retained as part of routine business records or as required by law or professional obligations. Even if the firm does not undertake representation, it may still retain certain information (including your inquiry) for conflict-checking, recordkeeping, and risk-management purposes consistent with professional obligations.

## **Your choices and requests**

You may request that the firm:

Provide access to the personal information you submitted through the Website

Correct inaccuracies in that information

Delete that information, subject to legal, professional, and recordkeeping obligations

To make a request, contact the firm using the information in the “Contact” section below.

## **Children's privacy**

The Website is not directed to children, and the firm does not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of thirteen (13). If you believe a child under thirteen (13) has submitted personal information through the Website, please contact the firm so that appropriate steps can be taken.

## **International visitors**

The Website is operated from the United States, and information submitted through the Website may be processed and stored in the United States. If you access the Website from outside the United States, you understand that your information may be transferred to and processed in the United States.

## **Changes to this policy**

The Website may include links to third-party websites. The firm is not responsible for the privacy practices or content of those sites.
