3 Phase Event, Saturday 21st and Sunday 22nd February 2026



Entry details

- Entries via Event Secretary.
- \$140 per horse
- Competition entries open 19 Dec 2025, and close at midnight 31st Jan 2026. The organisers may close entries if all available spaces are filled.

Phases

- Dressage: tests 1.1, 2.1, 3.1, 4.1, 5.1, 6, 7 will be held Saturday
- New Rules from Jan 2026 will apply for this competition.
- Ease of handling (EOH): obstacle course will be held both Sat & Sun
- Speed: timed obstacle course will be held Sunday

Phase information

- All ANWE Dressage tests can be downloaded from the ANWE website
- Ease of Handling (EOH) Obstacle rules can be downloaded from the ANWE website
- Course maps will be released by WELD with the rider draw

Camping

- One non powered camping site + one yard is provided per entry, Friday and Saturday nights. Toilet and shower facilities available.
- No temporary fencing is permitted, horse yards must be used.
- All yards must have all hay and manure removed prior to leaving the grounds.
- Manure pile is behind horse wash/toilet area.
- Dogs are to be on a lead at all times

Conditions of entry

- The competition is open to current affiliated ANWE members with a financially current ANWE rider levy number.
- All riders are required to volunteer at least an hour on the event roster. Failure to volunteer or provide a helper may result in refusal of entry/elimination and/or refusal of entry in future events held by WELD. No refunds, final decision will be made by ground jury.
- Sign up will be used to allocate volunteer positions and roster released one week prior to event.
- All competitors must sign into grounds office upon arrival in the club rooms.
- An unlimited waitlist will be active if entries exceed capacity.
