

COMPETITION GRADE

Competitor Grade is for more experienced riders who are comfortable with the training requirements and restrictions for each level. Cant go back to participant | Can go back 1 level if scored less than 58% comb dressage and Maneability score | Can go HC any level*

PARTICIPANT GRADE

To give inexperienced riders/horses the freedom to move between levels and gain experience and confidence.

Can move up and down these levels as needed | Participant rider can ride competition level horse*

LEVEL 1

Ridden on the lead line in a snaffle bridle

Two hands predominantly on the reins

Handler must be an Adult with a lead attached to the horse at all times whilst mounted

Rider can be assisted by Handler if needed

ANWE welcomes disabled riders

Horse min 4 yo

No Speed Phase

No Cattle Phase

LEVEL 2

Ridden predominantly with two hands

Walk and trot

Transitions in/out of the halt may be made through the walk

Horse min 3 yo

No Speed Phase (May run 2 Maneability phases)

No Cattle Phase

PRELIMINARY LEVEL 3

To be ridden predominantly with two hands and in sitting or rising trot.

Transitions up and down MAY be progressive

Horse min 4 yo

DEBUTANT W&F LEVEL 4 & 5

DEB W:

Ridden predominantly using two hands on the reins, and in sitting or rising trot.

Simple canter changes

Horse min 4 yo

DEB F:

Ridden using two hands on the reins in sitting trot

Canter flying changes

Horse min 5 yo

CONSAGRADOS 2 & 1 LEVEL 6 & 7

Ridden 2/1 hands

This level has greater degree of engagement and collection

Horse min 6 yo

MASTERS LEVEL 8

Highest level showing the result of correct and progressive training and quality riding.
