## Diabetes(insulin/tablets) and Weight Loss Medication Guide for Outpatient Testing

Check your blood sugar often (at least every 4 hours). Since you will be fasting, your blood sugar may drop faster than normal. If you have symptoms of low blood sugar, treat with glucose tablets OR 6 oz. of clear juice or carbonated beverage (coke, sprite, apple juice) and call the office.

Type 1 Diabetics with **insulin pump**. Contact your endocrinologist for further pump instructions.

Type 2 Diabetics-Follow the diabetes medication guide below as you prepare for your procedure.

## Helpful hint:

It is okay to take liquids containing sugar if a clear liquid diet has been prescribed.

Sample Diet: May substitute equivalent clear liquids 8 oz. Diet Soft Drink, 8 oz. regular Jello (no red or purple), 1 regular Popsicle (no red or purple), 8 oz. apple juice, broth
