 - *Shared all the events that scouting does--pinewood derby, camping. Pack 476 is a very active pack. THIS past month the topic of allowing GIRLS to join the pack. In 2019, girls were offered the opportunity to join boy scouts and cub scouts-- we decided to keep our just boys since we had girl scouts troops available.
 - *WHen girls are integrated into a cub scout pack, this will be done at a Pack level, but there will be different dens. Only thing that would really change is that girls would be wearing uniforms, we are used to siblings participating in most of our activities.
 - *MVES PTO is our Charter and we need approval.
 - *Most packs locally in our half of county allow girls and have family packs.
 - *Camping-- family camps would stay the same (fall camp)--you can only be in the tent that belongs to your family. Kids can only participate with entire family.
