We are called to stand in the gap as believers in the Messiah and pray and take a stand for the God of Israel and the nation of Israel.

Please pray for an end to the Coronavirus pandemic across the nations. Some have said that Passover will be a significant time this year and the virus will disappear over that time. That's a good thing to aim for, so let's join in praying for this.

Pray for the health of your local village, town and community. Pray for local services, for key workers in your area. Pray for your local hospitals and health systems.

In Matthew 24 Yeshua told us to be aware of the signs. What we are experiencing now is a 'birth pang'. We need to be alert to all that is happening and to keep warning people of the near return of our Messiah.

Nisan 1 (26 March 2020) was the Biblical new year, the start of the month for the Exodus from Egypt and the beginning of Jewish national history. It's also the beginning of the counting of the Festivals. So it's a new day. **Pray** that this year will be a year of revelation for the Jewish people.

Thank God for what appears to be a breakthrough following the election in March. Benny Gantz has broken the Blue and White Party in two to form a unity Government with Netanyahu.

Please pray for this Government.

Pray for Israeli believers have an advocate in this new government.

Pray for protection from enemy nations who would use this vulnerable time to do Israel harm.

Please pray for our work in Israel

Please pray for Ari and Shira Sorko-Ram and Kobi and Shani Ferguson, our senior leadership team in Israel. All have been in isolation and Shani has had symptoms of the Virus, although is now improving. The Fellowship of Artists incorporates all of our creative ministries: the development of modern Israeli

worship, helping young children in their vocal training and musicianship, supporting young artists in performance and recording a fresh new expression of sound. This is based at our studio in Jerusalem.

Pray for this project, that the team can still provide support remotely.

We have the opportunity to provide content for a new Hebrew language channel, Shelanu.

Please pray for us as we adapt some of our existing content and create some new content. This is a great opportunity to provide outreach content to reach Israel with the Gospel

Pray for wisdom and favour in carrying out such activities that will have a lasting impact on people's lives in Israel.

Focus: Istandwithisrael Passover project.

Our work in Israel continues despite the restrictions. We have an emergency project for Passover. Many Israeli families will not be able to celebrate Passover because the Government cannot provide financial aid until after that time. So we are raising a fund to provide coupons for food so that they can celebrate, otherwise they will have very little to purchase the basic requirements.

We shall also be providing believing families with a stipend where possible, to help them with food during April. **Please pray** that we would be able to raise funds and that we would be able to help many families.

Although all of Maoz UK's visits and speaking opportunities have been cancelled, there have been other opportunities to spread the good news about Israel. Brian, our Director, was able to record a series of two talks for the Sunday morning service at his home church about Israel. You can find them online here:

Maoz Israel UK Weekly Intercessors letter – 15-21 April 2020

In that day Israel will be one of three with Egypt and Assyria—a blessing in the midst of the land, whom the LORD of hosts shall bless, saying, "Blessed is Egypt My people, and Assyria the work of My hands, and Israel My inheritance." Isaiah 19:24-25

Pray for Israel neighbours.

It's only 300km from Jerusalem to Damascus. Often unrest from neighbours in the North spill over into Israel. The ongoing Syrian civil war means that the IDF always have to be on the watch for stray, and sometimes intentional, missiles.

Hezbollah in Lebanon have thousands of missiles pointed at Israel and have often threatened to use them. The borders with Egypt and Lebanon are relatively peaceful although terrorist groups are known to be operating in the Sinai who Egypt are trying to neutralise.

Please pray for continually improving relations with Jordan and Egypt.

Pray for the stability of governments in all our neighbours

Pray that Egypt will be successful in stopping terrorist cells in Sinai.

Pray for Lebanon. They have severe problems with their economy, and the current virus will make that worse. There have been riots, many cannot access their money from their banks, and the Lebanese government are seeking to restructure their massive debt. There is a real danger that Lebanon could fall into chaos.

Please pray for Maoz work in Israel amongst Arab people

We support a number of projects, including a worker in the Palestinian territories who oversees educational and medical help for those in need, home visits and special sessions for families, food parcels and support for families with severely disable children. Also help for those suffering domestic violence. It's a wonderful opportunity to share the love of Jesus.

Also, through our Fellowship of Artists project, we have been able to help the Sakhnini brothers to produce two music albums in Arabic for outreach to the Arabic speaking people in Israel, and further afield. It's our joy to be able to help reach our Arab cousins, we also supported them in a concert in Nazareth, where about 500 people, mainly believers were in attendance.

Please pray for the Arab people of Israel. According to Israel's Central Bureau of Statistics, the Arab population in 2019 was estimated at 1,890,000, representing 20.95% of the country's population. The majority of these identify themselves as Arab or Palestinian by nationality and Israeli by citizenship.

Please pray for the Palestinian Authority areas.

Pray for a release from corrupt governments and for democracy.

Pray for Gaza, the people are trapped and abused by Hamas, effectively a terrorist government. **Pray** for the small community of evangelical believers. Thousands have left the areas because of persecution.

Pray for the Gospel to go out without hindrance.

Feed Tel Aviv – the feeding programme for the homeless in Tel Aviv that is supported by local congregations. It is a small shop unit in-between two very busy brothels and feeds hundreds of people every week. Because of the restriction they cannot receive the hundreds of guests who normally go there. However, they have been making sandwiches and taking them on the streets.

Please pray that they will be able to find those in need.

Please pray for the volunteers, that they will stay healthy.

Please pray for sufficient food. The homeless really appreciate the home-made food.
